Subject: Staff-generated complaint, PDC Case 91596

Dear Aerospace Futures Alliance of Washington LTD:

On June 2, 2021, the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) notified you of alleged violations of RCW 42.17A.630 for failure to timely file Lobbyist Employer's Annual Reports (L-3 reports) disclosing lobbying activities for calendar years 2019 and 2020.

PDC staff have reviewed this matter and found the following:

- The PDC received Aerospace Futures Alliance of Washington LTD's L-3 reports for 2019 & 2020 on June 23, 2021, as required by RCW 42.17A.630. As a Lobbyist Employer, the yearly report is due by the last day of February of each following year, making your reports 480 and 115 days late, respectively.
- Aerospace Futures Alliance of Washington LTD completed a Statement of Understanding
 (SOU) and paid a \$200 civil penalty in accordance with WAC 390-37-143 (Brief
 Enforcement Penalty Schedule), acknowledging a violation of RCW 42.17A.630 for failing
 to timely file Lobbyist Employer's Annual Reports (L-3 reports) disclosing lobbying
 activities for calendar years 2019 & 2020. The \$200 penalty assessed resolves the allegation
 in this case.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1)(a). The PDC will not conduct a more formal investigation into these allegations or take further enforcement action in this matter.
