The Commissioners had before them the following materials:

- Case memorandum dated September 15, 2021, prepared by Jennifer Hansen, PDC Compliance Officer;
- Brief Enforcement Hearing Notice, PDC Case 94178, sent to Respondent on June 25, 2021, for Adjudicative Proceedings on July 15, 2021;
- 3. Initial Order Imposing Fine, PDC Case 94178, entered August 16, 2021;
- 4. Reconsideration Hearing Notice, PDC Case 94178, served September 15, 2021, and the corrected notice served September 17, 2021.

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

The matter involves an alleged violation of RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely file a Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 Report) no later than April 15, 2021, for calendar year 2020.

- 1. Ray LaFond served as a Park and Recreation Commissioner for Klickitat Recreation District during calendar year 2020, until his term expired. He resigned from further duties for medical reasons in December, 2020. The Respondent has no prior violations with the PDC.
- 2. Between February and May of 2021, PDC staff sent email reminders to all elected and appointed officials regarding their missing F-1 reports for calendar year 2020.

- 3. On May 11, 2021, PDC staff emailed warning letters to elected and appointed officials regarding their missing F-1 reports for calendar year 2020.
- 4. On June 25, 2021, PDC staff emailed the Respondent a hearing notice for a Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (Brief Enforcement Hearing) to be held on July 15, 2021. The hearing notice was sent to the Respondent's email address of record.
- 5. At the July 15, 2021, Brief Enforcement Hearing the Respondent was found in violation of RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely file the F-1 report no later than April 15, 2021, and was assessed a \$250 penalty, consistent with WAC 390-37-143, the Brief Enforcement Hearing penalty schedule adopted by the Commission.
- 6. On August 16, 2021, PDC staff served the Initial Order memorializing the Commission's ruling by email to the contact email address of record.
- 7. To date Respondent has not filed the F-1 report covering calendar year 2020 activity.
- 8. On August 19, 2021, Respondent contacted PDC staff by telephone to appeal the August 16, 2021, order based his significant health issues, including a stroke and partial paralysis, that prevented him from completing the F-1 report and resulted in his resignation from his position.
- 9. On September 15, 2021, PDC staff served Respondent by email with a hearing notice for a September 23, 2021, Hearing on Reconsideration before the Commission, along with instructions on how to participate in the hearing remotely. On September
