Hello,

I am the treasurer for Shukri Olow. I can find no rules on the Public Disclosure web site that indicate a change in donation amount if there is no primary.

"Revision Based on the dollar amounts established by the PDC, the campaign contribution dollar limit established in KCC 1.05.040(A) remains for the period years 2020 through 2021 at: Two thousand dollars (\$2,000) (\$1,000 per Election) In the aggregate during the period from January 1, after the date of the previous general election through December 31, after the upcoming general election, to any candidate for the office of King County Executive, County Council, Assessor or Director of Elections. Effective Dates This revision is effective January 1, 2020 and shall remain in effect until December 31, 2021."

Ironically, the actual campaign that filed this complaint has also accepted \$2,000 per person. We would like to file the very same complaint against his campaign.

I have had many conversations with the Public Disclosure commission and not once, has it ever been suggested that our limit was down to \$1,000 per person because we had no primary. We have not spent any money we raised for the general. I put it all in a savings account and have been very careful about that.

Please let us know why we are out of compliance as I truly do not understand, nor do I understand why a campaign would file a complaint for doing something that they are also doing!
