Dear Students First (Dominique France, Angela Chapman, and Melissa Wells):

Enclosed is a copy of an electronic letter sent to Sylvia Schultz concerning a complaint filed with the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC).

As noted in the letter to Sylvia Schultz, the PDC has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1) and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into these allegations or taking further enforcement action in this matter.

However, pursuant to WAC 390-37-060(1)(d), this letter serves as a warning letter concerning your failure to provide complete expenditure descriptions, properly report subvendor information, include occupation and employer information, and file a C-6 for an electioneering communication. The formal written warning includes staff's expectation that in future elections Students First timely files all required reports and that those reports include all required information. The Commission will consider the formal written warning in deciding on further Commission action if there are future violations of PDC laws or rules.

The complaint also alleged the Font Size on some advertising may have been smaller than the allowed minimum size. If Students First sponsors political advertising in the future, please ensure you are familiar with the minimum font size requirements, which can be found on the PDC's website.
