To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that the King County Democratic Central Committee has once again violated Washington State’s campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**). The violations are as follows:

1) Willful attempt to conceal source of thousands of dollars of in-kind contributions from the Public Disclosure Commission (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.750(2)(c), and note – RCW 42.17A.750(1)(g))

I recently realized that I was getting sloppy and missing obvious violations like the couple of violations I recently caught and for which I filed a complaint against the Whatcom County Democrats, so I decided I better start going back looking more closely at some of the other frequent violators of Washington State’s campaign finance laws. This led me to the King County Democrats and their filings, once again.

While reviewing some of the King County Democratic Party Central Committee meetings and looking at their livestreamed videos, it appears that some shady, illegal activities are happening and this committee is going the extra mile to conceal these violations from the public.

As an example of the evidence of this type of violation, I would point PDC staff to the following Facebook Live video feed of the February 26, 2019 KCDCC meeting. Forward to 1hour 32 minutes, and staff can review a discussion, debate, and description of a clear violation of Washington State’s campaign finance laws as the Treasurer and officers present a document clearly detailing “off-the books” in-kind “anonymous” contributions of “over \$3000,” which was never reported to the PDC:

Please note:

1. the KCDCC clearly presents a document (a copy of which I don't yet have) which details some apparently "off the PDC books" in-kind contributions of over \$3,000, which appears to be direct payments at "\$20 per hour" of at least two referenced individuals who were paid to assist the KCDCC in their fundraising efforts which had fallen on hard times recently.
2. A King County Democratic Party PCO clearly is concerned and goes to the microphone to express her concern about the "shadiness" and "the secrecy" of it all, particularly in light of the fact that the KCDCC recently went through a scandal related to a similar issue and was still paying fines to the State of Washington (based on the result of an Attorney General lawsuit and settlement which was initiated by a complaint filed by this author back in 2017 – see attached settlement agreement and original **PDC complaints – PDC Enforcement Case #32720 & #9861**)
3. KCDCC leadership clearly explain they are keeping the identity of the donor secret based on the donor's desires and they also go into more detail what this secret "off the books" cash in-kind contribution paid for (which implies two sets of books – one presented to the PDC as the "public" information and one for "insiders" which was apparently presented at this meeting.
4. Finally, the "secret" donor herself (I'm using this pronoun because there is no other pronoun option provided by the donor) gets up to the microphone and self-identifies to the group that she is the source of the funds based on a settlement she received through one of her companies and she just wanted to help the KCDCC.
5. When reviewing the contribution reports from 2018 – there are almost no "in-kind" contributions for that year.
6. When reviewing the contribution reports from 2019 – there are over \$6,000 of "in-kind" contributions reported, but none match the description of what is described in this meeting or explained by this donor.

There can be no doubt that the KCDCC, in their own words and by their own admission is concealing expenditures and at least thousands of dollars of in-kind contributions from the public, which is a clear violation of **RCW 42.17A.235 & .240**.

There can be no doubt that these violations are being done willfully, and with malice, therefore these violations should be subject to the penalties explained very clearly in **RCW 42.17A.750(2)(c)** which states:

"A person who, with actual malice, procures or offers any false or forged document to be filed, registered, or recorded with the commission under this chapter is guilty of a class C

felony under chapter 9.94A RCW.”

Additionally, I would suggest that PDC staff consider reviewing the additional civil penalties described in **RCW 42.17A.750(1)(g)**, which clearly states:

“A person who fails to report a contribution or expenditure as required by this chapter may be subject to a civil penalty equivalent to the amount not reported as required.”

Keep in mind, it isn't like this was an accident. The leadership of the KCDCC are openly explaining why they are breaking the law on video and documented by their own video of this meeting. **Then, a concerned member of the organization raises the very accurate concern that they shouldn't be breaking the law or doing anything “shady.”** Then, the “anonymous” donor comes up and admits that she indeed did give these funds to the KCDCC as an “in-kind” contribution to help the organization by paying these vendors “\$20 per hour” off the books.

It isn't the fault of the anonymous donor – she obviously has the best of intentions here and probably doesn't know the law anyway. The way the campaign finance laws are written, she doesn't need to know the law, but the KCDCC officers certainly do know the law – they are just deciding to violate it anyway.

It should also be pointed out that at least one person in attendance at this meeting was willing to raise the question in a public setting like this and **instead of realizing they were breaking the law and correcting their filings with the PDC, the leadership of the KCDCC chose to ignore these concerns and continue to violate the law.** This is particularly perplexing and evidence of willful malice because that same “anonymous donor” was willing to identify herself at the same meeting. Despite that, they still chose to conceal the truth from the public (if not from their internal membership).

King County Democrats - A history of law breaking

What is particularly surprising about this violation is that it comes only months after Washington State's Attorney General settled a lawsuit with the KCDCC based on numerous previous campaign finance violations which this author exposed in a complaint (see attached – **PDC enforcement Case #32720 & #9861**). As you can see over the past few years, regular payments were made to the State of Washington as part of the settlement of this lawsuit. See the following specifics (copies of the respective C4s are attached as reference):

1. July 2018 – Payment of \$1,000
2. January 2019 – Payment of \$4,000
3. July 2019 – Payment of \$4,000
4. December 2019 – Payment of \$4,000
5. July 2020 – Payment of \$4,000
6. January 2021 – Payment of \$4,000

7. July 2021 – Payment of \$3,769.50

So, while the KCDCC is in the middle of paying off their attorneys and the State of Washington the fines for the recent AG settlement for previous campaign finance violations, they are choosing to commit new violations. While they are hiding these violations from the public and the PDC, they are willing to openly discuss them with their membership and on video because apparently, they either don't take the law seriously, or they just don't care.

Regardless, this pattern of behavior is concerning and the PDC should investigate with the obvious concerns raised by this self-incriminating evidence helpfully provided by the KCDCC leadership on their Facebook page.

Top of the concerns should be just how many sets of financial books does this organization keep? Is it just two – one to present to the public and report to the PDC, and then another to admit to their membership? How many other violations are regularly concealed and not openly discussed at public forums like this?

It should also be noted that the terms of the AG settlement (see attached) include a requirement for this organization to follow the law, or if they break the law within the next 4 years (before 2022) they will be subject to paying an additional \$12,027.50 immediately (no payment terms). It looks like this crew clearly violated the terms of the stipulated settlement with the AG from 2018, and this bill should be included in their 2022 budget as well.

The staff at the PDC clearly have their work cut out for them in trying to untangle this mess and the open lawbreaking of the King County Democratic Party's Central Committee.

I'm sure I'll find more violations as I look closer, but this is just an open and obvious one.

What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?

The public has a right to know if a major political party is willfully concealing secret, anonymous donor in-kind contributions from the public and the PDC. This is particularly pertinent when this same organization is still under a stipulated settlement agreement with the Washington State Attorney General's office for previous lawbreaking and only recently finished paying part of the reduced fines from that settlement. Lawbreaking does not get better the more organizations like this break the law, although apparently it gets easier.

The anonymous donor, the PCO who actually took the effort to expose the violations, and the King County Democratic Party Central Committee leadership who chose to keep it secret from the public.

NAME OF ACCUSED: Allison Fine
DATE OF INCIDENT: February 26, 2019

DESCRIPTION OF CONDUCT: At the February 2019 Exec Board meeting, it was reported that a volunteer who wished to remain anonymous had made an in-kind donation of professional services, with the understanding that her identity would be disclosed only where needed to comply with public disclosure laws, but would not otherwise be made public. Allison forced the volunteer to out herself by making accusations that the volunteer and the KCDCC officers were “shady,” and proceeded to make derogatory remarks about the volunteer, including a statement that she was “a real piece of work.” Allison then heckled the volunteer's plea for kinder communications during Good of the Order, saying “oh, poor you” in a sarcastic tone.

**PDC Staff Generated Complaint against
King County Democratic Central Committee**

Complaint and Background:

On May 17, 2016, the King County Democratic Central Committee (KCDCC) filed a new Committee Registration (C-1pc report) listing Richard Erwin as Chair and Media Contact, Jayson Morris as Treasurer, and Omaha Sternberg as 1st Vice Chair. **(Exhibit 1)**

Between May 21, 2016 and July 19, 2016, KCDCC filed Cash Receipts Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 reports) and Campaign Summary Receipts & Expenditures reports (C-4 reports) covering the period January 1, 2016 through May 31, 2016.

On July 19, 2016, KCDCC filed its May 2016 C-4 report disclosing \$30,205 in aggregate monetary contributions for 2016 and \$9,772 in aggregate expenditures for 2016, with a Cash on Hand balance of \$20,433 as of May 31, 2016. **(Exhibit 2)** No additional C-3 or C-4 reports have been filed by KCDCC.

On August 21, 2016, Mr. Morris submitted his formal resignation as Treasurer for KCDCC. In August of 2016, Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) staff discovered, outside its office door, a laptop, cash box, and committee records that had been left at the PDC by Mr. Morris. PDC staff notified KCDCC Chair Richard Erwin, and he traveled to Olympia and picked up the laptop, cash box, and committee records.

On November 16, 2016, KCDCC filed an amended C-1pc listing Nancy Podschwit as its new Treasurer. **(Exhibit 3)**

Complaint Review Findings:

PDC staff queried the PDC contribution database and found that between October 14, 2016 and November 5, 2016, KCDCC made \$30,500 in monetary contributions to five candidates for public office. **(Exhibit 4)**

PDC staff queried the PDC expenditure database and found that seven political committees made monetary contributions to KCDCC totaling \$30,000 during the month of October 2016. **(Exhibit 5)**

Relevant PDC Statutes:


RCW 42.17A.205 states that political committees that are registered with the PDC are required to disclose any material change in information previously submitted in a statement of organization field with the commission within the ten days following the change.

RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 require political committees to file timely, accurate reports of contributions and expenditures, including C-4 reports that are required 21 and 7 days before each election, and in the month following the election, regardless of the level of activity. Beginning five months before the election, weekly C-3 reports are required to be filed every Monday disclosing monetary contributions received and deposited during the previous week.

Alleged Violations:


The facts referenced above provide reason to believe that the King County Democratic Central Committee may have violated: (1) RCW 42.17A.205 by failing to timely file an amended Committee Registration disclosing that Nancy Podschwit had replaced Jayson Morris as Treasurer; and (2) RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by failing to file or timely file C-3 reports of contributions and C-4 reports of contributions and expenditures, disclosing contribution and expenditure activities undertaken during calendar year 2016.

Based on this information, I am filing this complaint and directing staff to open an investigation into the allegations that the King County Democratic Central Committee may have violated chapter 42.17A RCW.

It has come to my attention that the King County Democratic Central Committee has committed additional violations of **RCW 42.17A**.

1) Failure to report pledges. (RCW 42.17A.235, .240)

According to the below article, the King County Democratic Central Committee received a pledge from Dow Constantine in November 2017. This was never reported, in violation of state law.

" Last night, Stober, who told me over the weekend that the organization was doing fine financially—"I am sitting in the Party office with the rent paid, lights on, heat blasting and nothing is suffering here," he said—suddenly produced a check for \$5,000 he said he had just procured; later, I confirmed that this check was from King County Executive Dow Constantine, who pledged the money in November and just paid up this month. "

In fact, the King County Democratic Central Committee has failed to report a single pledge as far back as PDC digital records go. This is highly concerning.

2) Failure to list all officers. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.205)

The KCDCC has failed to list all its board members (officers) on their C1-pc, listing a mere 3 people.

The board consists of over 70 officers, most of which are not listed.

" The vice chairs called on Stober to resign. Stober refused, criticizing the investigation as incomplete and overly vague. Defending himself, Stober told the *Times*, "The facts are three people that have called for my resignation out of a board of over 70.""

Interestingly, in the first link I listed, the treasurer said that she resigned "3 times", but this was never reflected in an updated C1-pc. This is cause for concern.

" Podschwit said that she had resigned three times over what she considered Stober's excessive spending, and that whenever she questioned him about spending funds that were not authorized by the adopted budget, she was told that he had "ultimate power.""

Please note, at this time this complaint is only being filed with the Public Disclosure Commission. These should be easy allegations to verify and either reject or confirm. This Committee is already in litigation with the Washington State Attorney General's office (**Thurston County Superior Court #17-2-02836-34**).

I. NATURE OF ACTION

The State of Washington (State) brings this action to enforce the State's campaign finance and disclosure law, RCW 42.17A. The State alleges that Defendant KING COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE, a Washington non-profit corporation, violated provisions of RCW 42.17A by failing to timely file and disclose contributions and expenditures in reports to the state Public Disclosure Commission. The State seeks relief under RCW 42.17A.750 and .765, including civil penalties, costs and fees, and injunctive relief.

II. PARTIES

2.1 Plaintiff is the State of Washington. Acting through the Washington State Attorney General, a local prosecuting attorney, or the Public Disclosure Commission, the State enforces the state campaign finance disclosure laws contained in RCW 42.17A.

2.2 Defendant KING COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE



1 (Committee) is registered as a Washington non-profit corporation. As the term is used under
2 RCW 42.17A.005(6)(c), it is the county central committee for the Washington State
3 Democratic Central Committee in King County, Washington.

4 III. JURISDICTION AND VENUE

5 3.1 This Court has subject matter jurisdiction over the present case, in accordance
6 with RCW 42.17A. The Attorney General has authority to bring this action pursuant to
7 RCW 42.17A.765.

8 3.2 This Court has personal jurisdiction over the Committee, a Washington non-
9 profit corporation with active membership and representatives in the State of Washington. The
10 Committee's headquarters are located in the State of Washington. It was required to timely file
11 complete reports of contributions received and expenditures made with the State Public
12 Disclosure Commission, which is located in Thurston County, Washington. It failed to do so.
13 Additionally, the acts and omissions complained of here took place in Thurston County.

14 3.3 Venue is proper in this Court pursuant to RCW 4.12.020(1).

15 IV. FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

16 4.1 RCW 42.17A declares as a matter of public policy "[t]hat political campaign
17 and lobbying contributions and expenditures be fully disclosed to the public and that secrecy is
18 to be avoided." RCW 42.17A.001(1). The statute further provides that the state's campaign
19 finance and disclosure law "shall be liberally construed to promote complete disclosure of all
20 information respecting the financing of political campaigns."

21 4.2 Washington's campaign finance law requires political committees to timely
22 report contributions received, including in-kind contributions. The information required to be
23 disclosed includes the name and address of the source of contributions that exceed \$25 in the
24 aggregate, and the employer and occupation of any individual contributor giving more than
25 \$100 in the aggregate. RCW 42.17A.235, .240; WAC 390-16-037. Contribution disclosures are
26 reported on a Public Disclosure Commission form "C-3" which is called the "Cash Receipt

1 Monetary Contributions” form.

2 4.3 Washington’s campaign finance law also requires political committees to timely
3 report expenditures related to state campaigns, including any debts incurred by the political
4 committee. RCW 42.17A.235, .240(8); RCW 42.17A.005(20). The PDC form to report
5 expenditures is called a “Summary, Full Report Receipts and Expenditures” and is a form
6 “C-4.” An expenditure is defined to include “a *promise to pay*, For the purposes of this
7 chapter, agreements to make expenditures, contracts, and promises to pay may be reported as
8 estimated obligations until actual payment is made.” RCW 42.17A.005(20).

9 4.4 The Committee is a political party committee as the term is used in RCW
10 42.17A, and is more specifically a county central committee of the Washington State
11 Democratic Central Committee. As such, the Committee routinely raises funds in order to
12 support various democratic candidates and ballot propositions. During 2016, the Committee
13 received contributions and made expenditures, all of which should have been reported in
14 accordance with RCW 42.17A.

15 Failure to Timely Report Contributions Received

16 4.5 The Committee failed to timely disclose contributions it received as required by
17 law on a form C-3 report. The following chart identifies for election year 2016 when the
18 Committee’s C-3 reports were due based on when contributions were deposited, the number of
19 days such reports were late, and the value of contributions that were untimely disclosed:

4.6 Of these contributions received, the Committee was required to disclose almost 67% (or \$49,437.80) before the November 8, 2016 General Election and failed to do so. As such, this contribution information was not publicly available until after the election.

Failure to Timely Report Expenditures/Deposits

4.7 In 2016, the Committee failed to timely disclose its expenditures as required by law on a C-4 report. The delinquencies are identified as follows:

a. January 2016 Report: On May 31, 2016, the Committee first filed its C-4 report for the January 1 through January 31, 2016 reporting period. The C-4 report disclosed expenditures totaling \$826.56 and deposits totaling \$1,114.22, which should have been reported February 10, 2016. These disclosures were reported 111 days late. The Committee subsequently filed an amended report for this period, ultimately disclosing \$826.56 in expenditures and \$1,114.18 in deposits.

b. February 2016 Report: On June 6, 2016, the Committee first filed its C-4 report for the February 1 through February 29, 2016 reporting period. The C-4 report disclosed expenditures totaling \$2,182.83 and deposits totaling \$2,953.31, which should have been

1 reported March 10, 2016. These disclosures were reported 88 days late. The Committee
2 subsequently filed an amended report for this period, ultimately disclosing \$2,182.83 in
3 expenditures and \$2,888.26 in deposits.

4 c. March 2016 Report: On June 7, 2016, the Committee first filed its C-4 report
5 for the March 1 through March 31, 2016 reporting period. The C-4 report disclosed
6 expenditures totaling \$4,501.85 and deposits totaling \$910.24, which should have been
7 reported April 11, 2016. These disclosures were reported 57 days late. The Committee
8 subsequently filed an amended report for this period, ultimately disclosing \$4,501.85 in
9 expenditures and \$910.20 in deposits.

10 d. April 2016 Report: On June 16, 2016, the Committee first filed its C-4 report
11 for the April 1 through April 30, 2016 reporting period. The C-4 report disclosed expenditures
12 totaling \$2,240.77 and deposits totaling \$2,835.15 which should have been reported
13 May 10, 2016. These disclosures were reported 37 days late. The Committee subsequently
14 filed two amended reports for this period, ultimately disclosing \$2,240.77 in expenditures and
15 \$2,086.15 in deposits.

16 e. May 2016 Report: On July 19, 2016, the Committee first filed its C-4 report for
17 the May 1 through May 31, 2016 reporting period. The C-4 report disclosed expenditures
18 totaling \$979.63 and deposits totaling \$17,240.57, which should have been reported June 10,
19 2016. These disclosures were reported 39 days late. The Committee subsequently filed an
20 amended report for this period, ultimately disclosing \$979.63 in expenditures and \$19,140.59
21 in deposits. The additional \$1,900 in deposits disclosed in this amended report were disclosed
22 173 days late.

23 f. July 2016 21-day Pre-primary Election Report: On November 21, 2016, the
24 Committee first filed its C-4 report for the June 1 to July 11, 2016 reporting period. The C-4
25 report disclosed expenditures totaling \$22,649.45 and deposits totaling \$4,235.74, which
26 should have been reported July 12, 2016. These disclosures were reported 132 days late. The

1 original C-4 report for this period included \$9,962.46 in expenses that were double-reported.
2 The Committee subsequently filed two amended reports for this period, ultimately disclosing
3 \$12,686.99 in expenditures and \$4,235.74 in deposits.

4 g. July 2016 7-Day Pre-Primary Election Report: On November 21, 2016, the
5 Committee first filed its C-4 report for the July 12 through July 25, 2016 reporting period. The
6 C-4 report disclosed expenditures totaling \$643.10 and deposits totaling \$1,063.57, which
7 should have been reported July 26, 2016. These disclosures were reported 118 days late. The
8 Committee subsequently filed two amended reports for this period, ultimately disclosing
9 \$562.50 in expenditures and \$1,063.57 in deposits.

10 h. September 2016 Post-Primary Election Report: On November 21, 2016, the
11 Committee first filed its C-4 report for the July 26 through August 31, 2016 reporting period.
12 The C-4 report disclosed expenditures totaling \$3,374.13 and deposits totaling \$2,145.87,
13 which should have been reported September 12, 2016. These disclosures were reported 70 days
14 late.

15 i. October 2016 21-Day Pre-General Election Report: On November 21, 2016,
16 the Committee first filed its C-4 report for the September 1 through October 17, 2016 reporting
17 period. The C-4 report disclosed expenditures totaling \$21,909.27 and deposits totaling
18 \$26,943.05, which should have been reported October 18, 2016. These disclosures were
19 reported 34 days late. The Committee subsequently filed two amended reports for this period,
20 ultimately disclosing \$21,909.27 in expenditures and \$26,693.05 in deposits.

21 j. November 2016 7-Day Pre-General Election Report: On November 21, 2016,
22 the Committee first filed its C-4 report for the October 18 through October 31, 2016 reporting
23 period. The C-4 report disclosed expenditures totaling \$16,177.56 and deposits totaling
24 \$7,933.57, which should have been reported November 1, 2016. These disclosures were
25 reported 20 days late.

26 4.8 In total, the Committee filed eleven C-4 reports a total of 879 days late. Six of

1 these reports were filed after the November 8, 2016 election and deprived the public of any
2 information about its expenditures and deposits prior to the election.

3 Failure to Timely Deposit Contributions

4 4.9 State law required the Committee to deposit contributions it received within five
5 business days of receipt. RCW 42.17A.220(1).

6 4.10 In 2016, the Committee failed to timely deposit 26 contributions it received
7 totaling \$14,977 within the five business day period. The following chart identifies for election
8 year 2016 the contributions the Committee held for more than five business days before
9 depositing the contribution:

V. CLAIMS

Plaintiff re-alleges and incorporates by reference all the factual allegations contained in the preceding paragraphs, and based on those allegations, makes the following claims:

5.1 First Claim: Plaintiff reasserts the factual allegations made above and further asserts that Defendant, in violation of RCW 42.17A.235, failed to timely disclose contributions it received to the Public Disclosure Commission.

5.2 Second Claim: Plaintiff reasserts the factual allegations made above and further asserts that Defendant, in violation of RCW 42.17A.235, failed to timely disclose expenditures it made, including but not limited to debts and obligations as of the time Defendant knew or should have known those amounts would exceed \$250 in value, to the Public Disclosure Commission.

5.3 Third Claim: Plaintiff reasserts the factual allegations made above and further asserts that Defendant, in violation of RCW 42.17A.220(1), failed to deposit at least 25 contributions it received within five business days of receipt.

VI. REQUEST FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests the following relief as provided by law:

6.1 For such remedies as the court may deem appropriate under RCW 42.17A.750, including but not limited to imposition of a civil penalty, all to be determined at trial;

6.2 For all costs of investigation and trial, including reasonable attorneys' fees, as authorized by RCW 42.17A.765(5);


6.3 For temporary and permanent injunctive relief, as authorized by RCW 42.17A.750(1)(h); and

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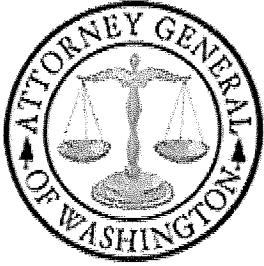
6.4 For such other legal and equitable relief as this Court deems appropriate.

AGO files campaign finance complaint against King County Democratic Central Committee

OLYMPIA —The Attorney General's Office (AGO) announced that it filed a complaint in Thurston County Superior Court today alleging campaign finance violations by the King County Democratic Central Committee (KCDCC). Specifically, the AGO asserts KCDCC failed to timely file a total of \$65,442 in expenditures and \$74,261 in contributions throughout 2016.

Attorney General Bob Ferguson recused himself from any involvement in the matter.

After the state Public Disclosure Commission began an investigation, the AGO received a Citizen Action Notice alleging multiple violations of the state's public disclosure laws in March 2017.

After receiving the notice, AGO staff determined KCDCC failed to timely file any reports of contributions received or expenditures made during election year 2016. An initial review showed numerous reports were filed between one and eight months late.

Among other reporting deficiencies:

- KCDCC received contributions from seven political committees totaling \$30,000, and failed to timely report the activity.
- In the weeks leading up to the 2016 general election, KCDCC made contributions to five candidates for public office, totaling \$30,500. KCDCC did not timely report those contributions.

KCDCC did not begin filing updated reports until Nov. 21, after the PDC staff began investigating, and two weeks after the Nov. 7 general election, inhibiting the public's right to know who is contributing to Washington political committees.

KCDCC also failed to timely update its committee information with the PDC when it appointed a new treasurer.

The state seeks penalties and injunctive relief. The defendant will have 20 days from the date they are served to respond to the state's complaint.

Senior Assistant Attorney General Linda Dalton and Assistant Attorney General Walter Smith are handling the case.

When the Attorney General's Office receives a Citizen Action Notice, it has 45 days to investigate and respond to the citizen. If the Attorney General's Office or local prosecutor does not start litigation, the individual may sue in the name of the state. If litigation is successful, any penalties awarded would go to the state, and the individual's attorney could recover attorney fees and costs. If the citizen's litigation is unsuccessful, the defendant may recover attorney fees from the state.

The Attorney General's Office enforces the state's campaign finance disclosure law to ensure free, open and fair elections in Washington state.

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on March 6, 2017. Your complaint alleged that the King County Democratic Central Committee may have violated: (1) RCW 42.17A.235, and .240 by failing to timely file Monetary Contribution reports (C-3 reports) and Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports) disclosing contribution and expenditure activities undertaken during the 2016 election; and (2) RCW 42.17A.205 by failing to timely file an amended Committee Registration (C-1pc report) within two weeks of the change of a principal committee officer, in this instance the political party committee Treasurer.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- The allegations contained in the complaint underlying PDC Case 9861 are substantially similar to a citizen action complaint, filed with the Attorney General's Office pursuant to RCW 42.17A.765.
- On May 12, 2017, the PDC became aware that a lawsuit containing substantially similar allegations as the complaint underlying PDC Case 9861 was filed in Superior Court in the name of Washington State.
- The Superior Court now has primary jurisdiction over the substance of this complaint, and the PDC will defer to its judgment in bringing the issues to resolution.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.

STIPULATION

The parties to this stipulation, Plaintiff, STATE OF WASHINGTON (STATE), and the Defendant, KING COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE, desiring to resolve all claims arising out of the State's First Amended Complaint and the related citizen action notices filed through the date of this Stipulation, hereby enter into the following stipulation:

- 1. Defendant KING COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE agrees to pay the State an assessed civil penalty in the amount of \$24,055 for its violations of RCW 42.17A for failing to report contributions received and expenditures made, failure to timely deposit contributions received and independent expenditures made in 2016, and failure to file expenditure reports with sufficient detail in 2016 and 2017.
- 2. The parties agree that \$12,027.50 of the assessed civil penalty will be suspended based on the following terms and conditions:
 - a. The suspension will be in effect for four years from the date of execution of the Judgment. During the period of suspension, Defendant KING COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE, agrees that it will not violate any provision of RCW 42.17A.
 - b. In the event Defendant KING COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE is found by the Public Disclosure Commission or a court to have committed a violation of RCW 42.17A during the suspension period, the suspended penalty of \$12,027.50 will immediately become due and payable within 30 days of such finding without further intervention of the Court.
 - c. If Defendant KING COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE is not found to have committed violations of RCW 42.17A by the Public Disclosure Commission or a

1 court during the suspension period, then the suspended portion of the penalty will be set
2 aside.

3 3. Defendant KING COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE agrees to pay the
4 State the total amount of \$12,742 as reasonable attorney fees, court costs, and costs of
5 investigation in this action.

6 4. Defendant KING COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE agrees to pay the
7 State the unsuspended portion of the civil penalty (\$12,027.50) and fees and costs
8 (\$12,742) as follows: \$1,000 payable by August 1, and then installments of \$4,000 on
9 January 1 and July 1 each year starting on January 1, 2019 until paid in full. The failure to
10 timely make any installment will result in the remainder of the unpaid portion to be due
11 within 30 days of the missed installment.

10 (\$12,742) as follows: \$1,000 payable by August 1, and then installments of \$4,000 on

12 timely make any installment shall result in the remainder of the unpaid portion to be due
13 within 30 days of the missed installment without further intervention of this Court.
