I appreciate the work of the PDC to keep our election system and our campaign finance fair and transparent; thanks for your diligence. I believe these allegations to be incorrect and would welcome your prompt review so that the matter can be settled guickly.

In response to the first allegation from Mr. Morgan, please find attached a copy of the certification I received from Cypress Renewables. I'm hopeful that this is sufficient to put the question to rest, but if there's more detail needed I'd be happy to help get that information to you.

With regards to the second allegation, Mr Morgan is correct that the business licenses for the company, 100% Possible LLC, has expired and I have not conducted any business through the company for several years (since before I became a State Representative). The company was never very significant, but I did have an agreement to do some work that related to a state agency in, I believe, 2016 and 2017. For that reason, it seemed appropriate to err on the side of extra transparency, which is why I opted to include it on the report. I believe I indicated on the F1 that last year the company made between 0 and \$12,000, which is correct, it made 0. I believe that I have followed the spirit and the intent of the law. But if an amended F1 form would clarify this, I'd be happy to make the amendment to remove the company.
