# **Memorandum**

Subject: Katie Rose Enforcement Hearing Memorandum: PDC Case 109822

## **Allegations:**

Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) staff alleges that Katie Rose, School Director for Bellingham School District 501, violated RCW 42.17A.700 by failing to file a Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) for calendar year 2021 that was due no later than April 15, 2022.

### **Background:**

- Katie Rose (the "Respondent") serves as School Director for the Bellingham School District 501. Her current term began on December 11, 2019.
- Pursuant to RCW 42.17A.700, an elected or appointed official who held office in 2021 was required to file a Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report), disclosing personal financial information for calendar year 2021, no later than April 15, 2022.
- From March 10, 2022 through April 5, 2022, PDC staff emailed reminders to elected and appointed officials regarding their missing F-1 reports for calendar year 2021.
- On May 11, 2022, PDC staff sent the Respondent a warning notice, by email and mail, regarding the missing F-1 report for calendar year 2021. The email was sent to the Respondent's personal & official email addresses.
- On August 11, 2022, PDC staff served the Respondent, by email and mail, with a hearing notice for an August 25, 2022 Adjudicative Proceeding (Enforcement Hearing) before the full Public Disclosure Commission concerning the Respondent's failure to file the F-1 report. The email was sent to the Respondent's personal and official email addresses.

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• As of August 17, 2022, the Respondent has not filed the F-1 report for calendar year 2021 that was due April 15, 2022.

#### **Prior Violation:**

The Respondent has one prior violation of RCW 42. 17A.700 within the last five years:

#### Violation (PDC Case 94088)

- The Respondent, who served as School Director for Bellingham School District 501, failed to file an F-1 report for calendar year 2020, which was due no later than April 15, 2021.
- At a July 15, 2021 Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (Brief Enforcement Hearing), the Respondent was found in violation of RCW 42.17A.700 and assessed a \$250 penalty for failing to file an F-1 report for calendar year 2020 that was due no later than April 15, 2021, with \$150 suspended if the conditions of the Order were met.
- To date, the Respondent has not filed the F-1 report covering calendar year 2020 or paid the outstanding \$250 civil penalty for case 94088, which was sent to collections.

## **Additional Information:**

The Respondent's most recent F-1 report was filed on August 28, 2020 and disclosed financial activity for calendar year 2019.

#### **Staff Recommendations:**

- Staff recommends the Commission find that the Respondent violated RCW 42.17A.700 for failing to file an F-1 report for calendar year 2021.
- Assess the Respondent a civil penalty of \$1,000 for a second occasion of a violation where the report was not filed before the date of the hearing per <u>WAC 390-37-182</u> to be made payable within 30 days of the date of the Order. The base penalty range for this fact pattern is \$1,000 \$2,000.
- Require the Respondent to file the missing F-1 reports covering calendar years 2020 & 2021 within 30 days of the date of the Order.
