Glen Morgan reported via the portal (Thu, 4 May 2023 at 5:34 PM)

To whom it may concern,

It has recently come to my attention that Spokane County Councilman Zach Zappone has committed various violations of Washington State's campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A). The violations are detailed below.

1. Failure to timely file Financial Disclosure Documents. Possible effort to conceal personal financial information from the public (Violation of RCW 42.17A.700, .710)

Zach Zappone is currently on the Spokane City Council, but before he barely won the election to this office in 2021, he ran a failed campaign for the Washington State Legislature in District 6, position 1 in 2020. This specific violation is from the time of that well-funded, but ultimately failed political campaign. Candidate Zappone, just like every candidate running for office, must file a financial disclosure form with the PDC within two weeks of when he originally filed to run for office on May 18, 2020. That F-1 should have covered his financial disclosure information for calendar year 2019. It appears he never did this. He did file a financial disclosure document for calendar year 2020 in early 2021 (see attached), but that is not a replacement for the personal financial information he concealed from the public during that well-funded but ultimately unsuccessful political campaign for the state legislature in 2020.

Please inform Councilman Zach Zappone that he must go back and correct his attempt to conceal this critical information from the public. I will note for the record, it appears that Councilman Zappone's challenges complying with the law appear to be a pattern of behavior with his recently filed late F1 for calendar year 2022 (See PDC Enforcement Case #136216).

2. Failure to accurately report income/contribution data with the PDC. Possible concealment of true source of campaign funds? (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, .240)

This part of the complaint also appears to involve both Councilman Zappone's failed Legislative campaign (which, interestingly enough, is still filing C3 and C4 documents years after that failed campaign has become nothing more than a painful memory). To understand this initial violation, I will explain what I found: First, review the third version (it was amended several times) of Zappone's first C-4 (Expenditure report) filed with the PDC (PDC C4 Report # 110015923 see attached). This final version of this first C-4 report claims that the campaign began with \$7,860 in the bank account rolled over from the previous campaign. First, this is not possible since this was Zappone's first Spokane City Council race, and there was no previous city council race to roll these funds into his campaign. Recognizing that he probably broke the law with this first report – even after three amendments – I reviewed his C-3 (contribution reports) to see if he ever reported where this money came from. He did not.

However, I did review the filed documents from Zappone's failed Legislative race, and it appears that Councilman Zappone might have transferred some of the remaining funds from that campaign to his new City Council campaign, but this is where the additional lawbreaking appears to just get worse. For example, this first C4 report for the Zappone for City Council race was supposed to cover the financial activity covering January 1 - January 31, 2021. This is the time period, according to the C4 Report #110015923 that this mystery \$7,860 was in the campaign bank account (why it took them three tries to get this amount right is an additional mystery). However, when you review the two transactions reported on the Zappone for State Legislature campaign (See PDC C4 Report # 110013514 attached) you can see the dates of transfer reported as being first \$6,115.00 on February 10th, 2021 and the second transfer reported as being on February 28, 2021. Please note that neither of these dates could possibly have been reported on a C4 report for the Spokane County Council race covering the

January 2021 timeframe if these transactions hadn't happened yet as reported by the failed Zappone State Legislature campaign. One or both reports are false and provide false information.

Another significant discrepancy that is exposed by comparing these two reports is that the amounts do not add up. Somewhere between the \$6,860 reported by the failed Zappone for State Legisature campaign and the "instant rollover cash hoard" of \$7,860 reported by the 3rd version of the Zappone for Spokane City Council race, a mystery \$1,000 was conjured into existence without attribution of original source or proper reporting as required under RCW 42.17A.235.

I will point out that this campaign uses the same treasurer, Andrew Taylor, for both campaigns, so it seems unlikely that they couldn't figure out the math. Additionally, if the first C4 filed by the Zappone for Spokane City Council race is incorrect, this means every C4 after that is inaccurate, and even a first time amateur treasurer would know to check Line18 from the C4 with the bank statement from the previous month. Clearly this was not done, or someone secretly inserted an extra unreported \$1,000 into this campaign. Which leads to the next obvious legal violation by this crew...

3. Illegal contribution from one candidate political campaign to another political campaign (Violation of RCW 42.17A.430(8))

The failed Zappone for state legislature campaign committee appears to have attempted to circumvent the clear legal prohibitions as explained in RCW 42.17A.430(8) when they reported a transfer of \$1,000 to the Zappone for Spokane City Council committee (See PDC Report 110019711 on 4/3/2021 – attached). While this transfer of funds would be illegal on its face, the Zappone for City Council race decided to just pretend it never happened, and so they reported nothing from this transaction. There are no corresponding C3s that match this mystery, illegal \$1,000 contribution. This would be an additional violation by concealing this information from the public, just as this campaign did with the initial "transfer" contributions that were never reported on any C3 at any time by this campaign (again, specifically, this is a violation of RCW 42.17A.235, .240)

4. Failure to get written approval by donors to transfer funds to campaign for different office (Violation of RCW 42.17A.490)

Based on the slipshod reporting, the apparent illegal collusion between these two political campaigns, sharing of the treasurer, and the obvious failures by the Zappone campaign to even marginally comply with Washington State campaign finance laws, it appears extremely likely that this campaign completely failed to get formal written approval to transfer these unaccountable funds left over in his failed 2020 legislative campaign to transfer to his Spokane City Council race.

PDC staff should request evidence of this written approval because the circumstantial evidence seems to indicate this was never done according to the legal requirements defined in RCW 42.17A.490.

Finally, I will point out that this candidate has self-reported his expertise in following Washington State's campaign finance laws when he responded to the PDC during an investigation of his campaign by PDC staff in 2021 (See PDC Enforcement Case #99799). He presented himself as extremely knowledgeable at the time, yet it appears while he was putting on that façade to PDC staff for one type of violation and investigation, his campaign was clearly operating in total defiance of the law as explained above.

This should invite a much more detailed level of scrutiny of this campaign and perhaps some required education of this political candidate and his treasurer so that they become more effective at following the law in the future. Between these two political campaigns, they have acquired and spent almost \$300,000, and this should be more than enough cash and experience to learn how to follow the law. Let me know if you need any additional information.
