This is to notify you that the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has opened a formal investigation, and on the above date, PDC Staff will conduct a case status review (initial hearing) concerning a complaint filed September 11, 2017 by Roger Lenk. The complaint alleges that Kennewick Public Facilities District (KPF) officials (Barbara Johnson and Corey Pearson) may have violated RCW 42.17A.555 by using, or authorizing the use of, the facilities of the KPF to promote Proposition 17-4, a ballot measure on the November 7, 2017 general election ballot.

The case status review (initial hearing) is not an adjudicative proceeding. It is conducted in accordance with WAC 390-37-071, and is intended to provide you with information concerning the investigative process, including possible alternatives to resolve the matter.

You are not required to participate in the hearing. Further, your failure to participate will not prejudice your rights concerning the investigative process, or any potential future adjudicative proceeding in the matter.
