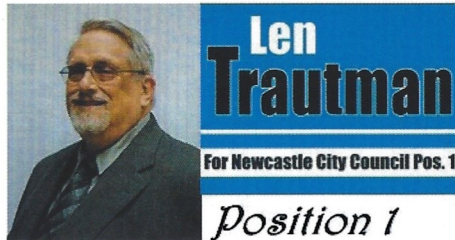

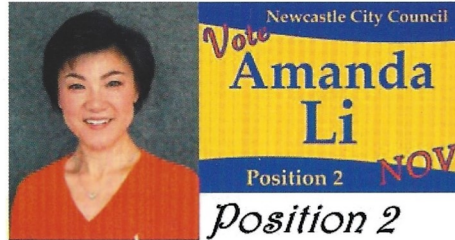


I have attended every council meeting for over two years. I am familiar with all the issues facing the city and I am ready to go on day one. I want to be of service.

I will use my lifetime of community involvement to keep Newcastle a strong, independent and fiscally responsible city.



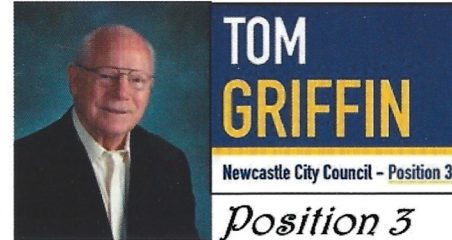

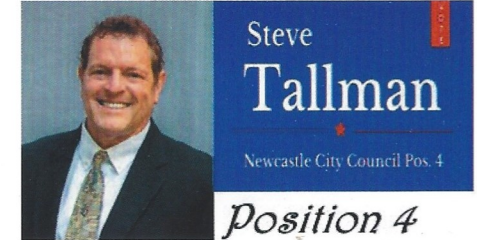
