As your representative in Olympia, I have worked to expand health care, fund basic education, create rent-restricted social housing, provide free college and university tuition for all low-income students, help workers organize, protect our air and water, provide a remedy for decades of racial discrimination in homeownership, and enact a prescription for a home to support our chronically homeless neighbors suffering on the street due to a medical condition.

As I begin the next chapter of my community service, I do so with the confidence that our district has a new and passionate advocate with all the qualities to be an effective lawmaker and community leader in Shaun Scott.


As the Policy Lead at the Statewide Poverty Action Network and champion for anti-poverty programs, Shaun has worked in collaboration with other economic justice advocates, urging the State Legislature to expand social safety net programs, enact strong consumer protections, and fund affordable housing and disability services.

Shaun was part of the coalition that secured the passage of the Working Families Tax Credit as well as the Fair Start for Kids Act with funding for child care and early learning from the state capital gains tax. Last year, Shaun and I worked closely together to pass HB 1474, a groundbreaking law that addressed racial discrimination with homeownership assistance to families redlined from many neighborhoods.

That record of results has earned Shaun one of the broadest coalitions of support including Democrats, labor unions, community organizations, elected leaders, and neighbors across our district and across Washington state.

I respectfully urge you to support Shaun this election for a fair, inclusive, sustainable, and accessible Washington for all.
