It's my honor to fight to expand health care, fund education, create job opportunities, make our economy more fair, help workers organize, protect our air and water, and stand in solid opposition to anti-immigration policies.

As I begin the next chapter of my service, I do so with the confidence that our state has a new and passionate advocate with all the qualities of an effective legislator in policy and community leader David Scott.

As the Policy Lead at the statewide Poverty Relief Network and champion for anti-poverty programs, he has worked in partnership with other legislators, public advocates, urging the state legislature to support social safety net programs, smart zoning, universal prekindergarten, and local affordable housing and disability services.

He's also part of the coalition that secured the passage of the Working Families Tax Credit and the state capital gains tax, and in 2021, he co-authored H.B. 526, Washington State's family security plan. In January, I'll be working with community members and staff to the legislature to continue building on these successes, prioritizing investments in education and child support for all, and working to protect families' communities and future generations.
