In accordance with RCW 42.17A.110 and RCW 42.17A.755, the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) will hold an enforcement hearing concerning the allegation that Shaun Scott violated 42.17A.235, 42.17A.240, WAC 390-16-042, WAC 390-16-205, and WAC 390-16-043, RCW 42.17A.320 and WAC 390-18-010, RCW 42.17A.445 and WAC 390-16-239 by failing to abide by the requirements outlined in RCW 42.17A.

Please see the attached Amended Results of Investigation (ROI) for full details of the alleged violations.

The Commission has scheduled a hearing to decide if the violations occurred, and, if necessary, assess a penalty. The Commission may also decide if it will accept a Stipulation (informal settlement) by the parties as to facts, violations and/or penalties, if the parties propose such a Stipulation. See [WAC 390-37-090](#). The Commission also has the authority to assess a civil penalty in accordance with [WAC 390-37-182](#), the Enforcement Hearing penalty schedule adopted by the Commission.

**You may send evidence in your own behalf or in mitigation no later than 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 16, 2025, for review by Commission members.** You may do so by writing to the Chair, Public Disclosure Commission, P.O.
