<p>Glen Morgan</p> <p>Mon, 1 Jul 2024 at 7:03 PM</p> <p>To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It has come to my attention that the Pierce County Young Democrats PAC has violated Washington State's Campaign Finance Laws (RCW 42.17A) during their 2021 PAC activities. The violations are as follows:</p> <p>1) Illegal acceptance of overlimit anonymous contributions (Violation of RCW 42.17A.220(4))</p> <p>Based on the information reported by this campaign to the PDC at the time, it appears that this campaign has accepted \$500 in anonymous contributions (See PDC C3 # 110217808– attached for reference). This campaign had only reported raising enough money to accept up to \$300 in anonymous contributions as the statute so clearly details in RCW 42.17A.220(4), so at least \$200 must be forfeit of this secretive anonymous contribution.</p> <p>Please note, at the time these illegal anonymous contributions were secretly transferred into this PAC's account, the legal limit for anonymous contributions was \$300, so this PAC must forfeit (escheat) at least \$200 to the state treasurer as specifically required in RCW 42.17A.220(4).</p> <p>I have no idea how I missed this in my last batch of complaints, but better to catch the lawbreakers late than never.</p> <p>2) Failure to provide accurate, updated information on C1PC report (Violation of RCW 42.17A.205(1), (4))</p> <p>The general sloppiness and failure to follow the law by this PAC is also reflected in the fact that they haven't updated their formation documents (C1PC) filed with the PDC despite numerous changes in leadership since their most current C1PC document was filed (See PDC C1PC #10077518 attached for staff reference). If one were to look at their website which lists their current leadership, you will see none of the names or positions are the same. It seems likely that this information has changed repeatedly over the past 5 years, yet it has</p>

never been updated or corrected as clearly required in RCW 42.17A.205(4). Another clear and obvious violation of Washington State's glorious campaign finance laws.

I'm sure numerous other violations have been committed by this organization, but it will take a complete financial audit to get to the bottom of it, so this is just a good place to start.
