(CMS) (Respondent), did not timely and accurately file one or more C-3 or C-4 reports with the	
Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) as required by RCW 42	2.17A.235 and RCW 42.17A.240.

The Respondent would like to avoid the time and expense resulting from a Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (Brief Enforcement Hearing) before the Presiding Officer. Therefore, in lieu of a hearing, the Respondent acknowledges that it violated RCW 42.17A.235 and RCW 42.17A.240 and agrees to enter into this *Statement of Understanding* to resolve this matter with the Public Disclosure Commission.

Background

- In 2020, the committee's treasurer of record, Dean Ledford, had personal health and family matters that kept him from performing treasurer duties.
- In 2020, the committee disbanded and became inactive.
- From 2020 through 2023, Citizens for Marysville Schools was not actively fundraising or participating in election efforts.
- Despite this, Marysville School District (MSD) was sending payroll-deducted contributions to CMS through direct deposit until December 20, 2022.
- Payroll-deducted contributions from 2020 through 2022 from MSD to CMS totaled \$16,237.06.
- In 2022, CMS contributed its remaining funds of \$26,900 to Best Schools Marysville, a new committee participating in support of school bonds and levies.
- As of September 2023, CMS had a small balance of \$166. It contributed these funds to Best Schools Marysville to close out the bank account.

The Respondent understands that this will resolve all issues with the PDC regarding their failure to timely file the C-3 and C-4 reports in question.

The Respondent further understands that by signing this SOU, they acknowledge the violations of RCW 42.17A and Title 390 WAC set forth above and waive their right to a hearing in this matter. The Respondent further understands that signing this SOU and returning it to the PDC will resolve the issue of the late filed C-3 and C-4 reports.
