Good afternoon - my apologies for my late response to this. I've been out of town quite a bit lately.

The city attorney was consulted on this matter and he determined that this would not be a violation.

The City Council has publicly debated and supported other ballot measures including a recent Spokane County public safety Measure 1 in 2023, Central Valley School District Bonds and Levies, and Fire District measures in the past.

When Councilmember Cargill brought this up in a workshop, the council then voted 4-3 to bring these measures back in resolutions back for consideration. There were two resolutions: One was for Initiative 2117 which passed 4-3. The other, for Initiative 2066 was read by title only but there was not a motion or a second to move it forward.
