Ms. Blacksmith,

Thanks for the email, and notice regarding dismissal of the allegation concerning the photo in uniform. I'm assuming a response to that allegation is not necessary, but please let me know if this is not correct.

My response to the remaining two allegations is as follows:

Allegation One, failing to timely and accurately report the expenditure for the postcards sent in October, is unfounded. The expenditure was made in two parts, the first from a personal checking account in the late evening of October 14, 2024, and the second with a credit card in the morning of October 15, 2024, both *after* the filing of the October 14, 2024 C4 report. *See* attached emails. Both expenditures posted to my personal accounts, the first to checking and the second to a credit card, on October 15, 2024, again, after the October 14, 2024 C4 had been filed. *See* attached redacted account statements. So, as I understand it, this was an October 15, 2024 expenditure and the report of this expenditure is not due until tomorrow, October 29, 2024.

That said, I do have a question as to how to properly report this expense. I paid for this expense from my personal account because our campaign account had insufficient funds. So, I tried to report it as an in-kind contribution for the total of \$6,050.07. *See* attached redacted account statements. Again, I did this because the funds did not go into or come out of the campaign account. My report of this in-kind contribution comes up when I perform a "contribution search" but I cannot find a way to file it. Could you assist with this?

Allegation Two, allegedly using public agency resources to assist an election campaign through use of a courtroom photo is also unfounded. The photo in question was taken from a video shot, produced, and published by King 5 News and posted to YouTube, *see* [Robbrie Thompson sentenced to 40 years for 2019 murder of Puyallup store clerk](#). It included footage of me arguing in court. The video was taken without my knowledge or prior permission by a person not employed by Pierce County while I was engaged in the normal and regular conduct of my work. Therefore, no public resources were used or authorized to be used in the production of this photo and it is not violative of RCW 42.17.555. I have, however, removed this photo from my website pending your decision.

Lastly, I would note that the complainant seems to indicate in his apparent LinkedIn profile that he is a "Consultant at Progressive Strategies NW," which, per its website, "brings... passion for electing great candidates." This seems to suggest an ulterior motive of unnecessarily hampering my campaign, which is not guided by a consultant, but a lawyer seeking to make the court system more just and efficient.

I want to assist you and ensure my compliance with applicable law and regulation. So, please let me know if you need anything additional from me or have further questions or concerns.
