<p>Conner Edwards reported via the portal (Fri, 27 Sep 2024 at 1:56 PM)</p> <p>Description of Complaint</p> <p>1) As indicated here, this election has a bond on the 2024 general election ballot, see link: https://www.isd411.org/about-us/bondsandlevies/common-questions . This being the case, it has to file weekly C3 reports. As such, this C3 for a \$1000 deposit was 11 days late, see link: https://apollo.pdc.wa.gov/public/registrations/campaign-finance-report/110247554 .</p> <p>2) For EY 2022, this respondent’s final C4 covered May of 2022, and disclosed an ending balance of \$11,357.18 . See link: https://apollo.pdc.wa.gov/public/registrations/campaign-finance-report/110088967 . For EY2024, this respondent’s first C4 was filed covering July of 2024. It reported a starting balance of \$44,479.18. See link: https://apollo.pdc.wa.gov/public/registrations/campaign-finance-report/110237367 . This suggests that there was a significant number of contributions which have not yet been disclosed to the public. It is essential that the committee disclose this information to the public before the November election is concluded.</p> <p>3) The expenditures disclosed by this committee in EY2022 are replete with issues, see link: https://www.pdc.wa.gov/political-disclosure-reporting-data/browse-search-data/committees/co-2022-25073/expenditures .</p> <p>Here are a few examples:</p> <p>a) Virtually all of the expenditures for printing do not list the number of items printed.</p> <p>b) Many of the expenditures listed as “PTA postcard mailing” appear to be failing to disclose the subvendors used to do the printing/mailing at issue.</p> <p>c) There is an expenditure for “FACEBOOK AD BOOSTING” but the run dates/number of impressions is not included. I understand that agency staff believe this is required.</p> <p><u>Notice to Respondent</u></p> <p>I apologize to you for any inconvenience caused by this complaint.</p> <p>This complaint is one of hundreds that I have filed to highlight and ultimately fix the significant shortcomings associated with the agency responsible for administering our state’s campaign finance laws.</p> <p>What are these shortcomings?</p> <p>Overcomplicated and outdated requirements that are difficult to understand and comply with. Failure to properly educate filers about the tasks they must perform to remain in compliance with applicable requirements and avoid complaints. Failure of the agency to send regular reminders to filers about pending deadlines. A failure to proactively enforce applicable requirements which enables the complaint system to become weaponized. Non-intuitive, non-user friendly, and buggy reporting software. Failure to meaningfully enforce core requirements. Failure to follow the best operating practices of other neighboring campaign finance agencies. An agency leadership structure that largely disregards stakeholder input and is slow to identify and resolve major agency deficiencies.</p> <p>I believe that the best way to motivate the agency to address these problems is by filing a large number of complaints so that the agency’s problems become impossible to ignore.</p> <p>Slowly (too slowly) this strategy is starting to yield concrete and beneficial changes. 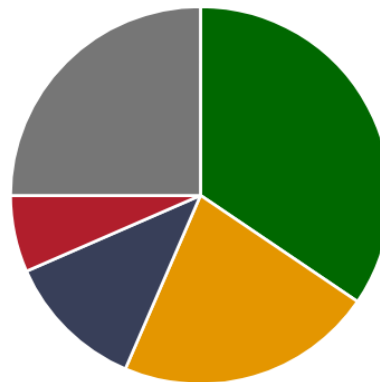
