<p>Eric Halvorson reported via the portal 16 days ago (Mon, 28 Oct 2024 at 7:36 PM)</p> <p>"Hide it under a bushel? Yes! We must not let this shine!" - PursuitPac, probably.</p> <p>It appears that PursuitPAC has been engaged in their mission for more than a year without filing a single report with the PDC.</p> <p>In 2023, the PAC opted for Mini-Reporting, so we have to assume that they brought in and spent less than \$7,000 and didn't get any donation larger than \$500 from any one source, but in 2024, the PAC opted for Full Reporting and is almost 10 months behind with this reporting.</p> <p>We do not know who gave them money. We do not know where they are spending it.</p> <p>We do know that the PAC has a website, but we don't know who paid for it.</p> <p>We don't know how much they spent on the October 14th Event with Dave Reichert at the Pursuit Church Kirkland Campus. We don't know if the church donated their space to the PAC, who paid for any refreshments, A/V equipment, etc. (Pursuit Pac, 2024a)</p> <p>We can only assume that the Voter's Guide the PAC compiled has been distributed somehow, but we don't know where, we don't know how, and we don't know who paid for that.
