<p>Glen Morgan reported via the portal (Tue, 15 Oct 2024 at 5:13 PM)</p> <p>To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It has come to my attention that the Cowlitz County Democrats (Democratic Central Committee PAC), has, once again, violated Washington State’s campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A). The details are as follows:</p> <p>1) Attempt to conceal true sub vendors and legally required details from the public on expenditures (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240, WAC 390-16-037, WAC 390-16-205)</p> <p>This secretive, shady, dark money PAC has once again violated Washington State’s campaign finance laws despite the simplicity, clarity, and very obvious requirements explained in WAC 390-16-037, example B, and WAC 390-16-205 when they sloppily reported legally deficient information in their reports about many expenditures. Despite the ease of complying with Washington State’s campaign finance laws, this crew decided to clearly threaten Democracy by failing to provide the legally required details as so obviously explained in WAC 390-16-037, example B, and worse than this – they also failed to provide the sub-vendor information for an inquiring public to know. Who printed the signs? Where are they located? Was it a foreign corporation located in China? Was it Russia? Who knows, and these guys aren’t talking. As if these egregious violations were not enough, they also decided to conceal from the public which candidate (or candidates) these signs are supporting. Again, WAC 390-16-205 is so clear on this matter, yet they decided to break the law anyway. They did this so often, I am required to break down the many variety of examples:</p> <p>Examples #1-9 – (See PDC C4 expenditure Report # 110252505, attached for staff reference): 9/3/2024 – Vendor “Church Les” for “Reimbursement for lumber and materials” Cost of \$148.61 Also see similar lack of details for “Church Les” on 9/9/2024 for a cost of \$47.79 Also see similar lack of details for “Church Les” on 10/2/2024 for a cost of \$46.71 (No sub vendors – where did the “lumber” or “materials” come from? – See WAC 390-16-205) 9/4/204 – Vendor “MPG Marketing and Mailing services” for “Printing signs” – Cost of \$370 9/20/24 – Vendor “MPG Marketing and Mailing services” for “Candidates and campaign signs” – Cost of \$2,423.48. (No sub vendors – where did they actually print the signs? No details for which candidates for how m any signs per each candidate?- no details for how many signs – see WAC 390-16-037, example B) Two expenditures to vendor “VO Printers” – one on 10/10/2024 for \$218.56 for “voting guide handouts” and one on 9/23/2024 for \$434.97 for “flyers for canvassing” (again, no details as WAC 390-16-037 so clearly explains)</p> <p>9/26/2024 – Vendor “Columbia River Reader” was paid \$637 for “ads in paper”</p> <p>(Again, no details as WAC 390-16-037, example A so clearly requires – what dates did the ads run?)</p> <p>On 10/8/2024 – they accepted an in-kind contribution of “candidate signs” for \$624.84 from the WA State Democrats (Total violation of WAC 390-16-205 – no sub vendor details – who printed the signs? No details for how many signs, and no explanation for which candidates these signs were for? WAC 390-16-037 clearly violated here too)</p> <p>Examples 10-12 - (See PDC C4 expenditure Report # 110243126, attached for staff reference).</p> <p>On this report, there were two categories of similar violations:</p>

The first was reimbursements of \$221.96 on 8/7/2024 and \$163.71 on 8/26/2024 to “SIIPOLA Rosemary” but no sub vendor information was provided for the various reimbursements. This is clearly required now under PDC staff interpretation of **WAC 390-16-205**. **They clearly broke the law here.**

The other category was a \$1,513.00 expenditure on 8/20/204 to “MPG Marketing and Mailing Services” for “yard signs and holders” with no legally required details, no sub vendor information for where they are actually printed, and no clarification for which candidates (how many to each). Total violation of both **WAC 390-16-037, example B**, and also **WAC 390-16-205**. Just **more shady lawbreaking**.

While this clear threat against Democracy, Freedom, and the very future of our state must be addressed, this violation also needs to be put in the context of this organization’s previous shameful history of lawbreaking.

A Sad, Shameful history of breaking the law

This isn’t the first time I’ve caught this crew breaking the law. Back in 2017, I caught them egregiously late in filing their reports and keeping large volumes of information secret from the public (**See PDC Enforcement Case #26715**, original complaint attached for staff reference), and the PDC let it go with a “Reminder letter”

Earlier this year, I filed a complaint against this shady crew for a variety of lawbreaking including concealing the truth from the public. The PDC agreed that this shady operation was breaking the law. The PDC issued a formal warning letter to this crew just a few months ago (**See attached PDC Enforcement Case #149725 Warning letter**).

With that consistent history of lawbreaking, an obvious pattern of behavior, it appears that PDC Warning Letters are not enough to convince these guys to follow the law, and it seems appropriate that compliance be obtained through a PDC fine at least, if we are to save Democracy, of course.

To Whom it May Concern --

It has come to my attention that the Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee have habitually and willfully committed frequent and multiple violations of **RCW 42.17A**.

1) Failure to file accurate, timely C3 and C4 reports. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235)

State law requires that candidates and committees file frequent, accurate reports of contributions, expenditures, in-kind contributions, and debt. Unfortunately, the Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee has failed on numerous occasions to do this. (See **Exhibits A - "Illegally late reported C3 and C4 reports"**)

2) Failure to accurately, timely report debt. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240 (8), see WAC 390-05-295)

State law requires that the name and address of any person and the amount owed for any debt, obligation, note, unpaid loan, or other liability in the amount of more than two hundred fifty dollars or in the amount of more than fifty dollars that has been outstanding for over thirty days be reported on form C4. Per **WAC 390-05-295**, this includes any oral or written order placed, debt or obligation to purchase goods or services or anything of value, or any offer to purchase advertising space, broadcast time or other advertising related product or service.

The Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee illegally failed to report the following debts: (See **Exhibit B - "Illegal failure to timely report debts"**).

**3) Failure to properly break down, describe expenses.
(Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, see WAC 390-16-205, WAC 390-16-037)**

State law requires that expenditures made on behalf of a candidate or political committee by any person, agency, firm, organization, etc. employed or retained for the purpose of organizing, directing, managing or assisting the candidate's or committee's efforts shall be deemed expenditures by the candidate or committee. In accordance with **WAC 390-16-037** and **WAC 390-16-205**, such expenditures shall be reported by the candidate or committee as if made or incurred by the candidate or committee directly. Additionally, in accordance with **WAC 390-16-037**, the exact purpose of the expenditure, the quantity of items printed, and the individual value of broadcast ads distributed on various media outlets must be disclosed on form C4.

The Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee illegally failed to break down the following expenses. (See **Exhibit C - "Illegal failure to break down expenditures"**)

The PDC should investigate the possibility that the Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee committed the above violations maliciously, which would be a class C felony per **RCW 42.17A.750 (2)(c)**. If the PDC determines that is the case, they should refer the case to the Attorney General's office for criminal prosecution immediately. Please don't hesitate to contact me if you need any additional information.

Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review and assessment of the complaint you filed on Feb. 26, 2024. The complaint alleged the Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee, a political committee, may have violated RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by failing to timely and accurately disclose expenditures and contributions on reports.

PDC staff reviewed the allegations; the applicable statutes, rules, and reporting requirements; the response provided by the Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee; the applicable PDC reports filed by the Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee; and other relevant information, to determine whether the record supports a finding of one or more violations.

Based on staff's review, we found the following:

- On Oct. 3, 2023, the Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee registered the Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee Exempt account, filing under full reporting.
- As noted in the complaint, the Washington State Democratic Central Committee (WSDCC) reported contributing \$1,955 to the Cowlitz County Democrat Central Committee on August 23, 2023.
- In response to the complaint, Rosemary Brinson Siipola, Chair Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee, provided a copy of the Oct. 3, 2023 registration and a Cash Receipts Monetary Contributions (C-3) report filed with the PDC on Oct. 5, 2023 listing the \$1,955 contribution from the WSDCC received on Sept. 19, 2023 and deposited on Oct. 5, 2023.
- RCW 42.17A.235 describes the required filing deadlines for disclosure of campaign finance activities including monetary contributions, including the requirement a committee deposit all contributions within five business days of receipt and also file a report on the 10th day of the month if contributions of \$200 or more are received in the prior month. Per RCW 42.17A.235, the Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee was required to deposit the \$1,955 contribution before or on September 26, 2023.
- The donation from the WSDCC to the Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee was deposited nine days late.

Based on our findings staff has determined that, in this instance, the failure to timely deposit the contribution does not amount to a violation that calls for further investigation.

Pursuant to WAC 390-37-060(1)(d), however, the Cowlitz County Democratic Central Committee will receive a formal written warning concerning the requirement under RCW 42.17A.235. Staff expects the committee, moving forward, to timely deposit contributions and file all required reports. If violations of PDC laws or rules occur in the future, the Commission will consider this formal written warning in deciding on further Commission action.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action necessary and has dismissed this matter per RCW 42.17A.755(1).
