Dear Public Disclosure Commission,

I am writing to address the recent complaint submitted by Mr. Joe Kunzler regarding my residency and financial obligations. I appreciate the opportunity to clarify these matters and provide accurate information.

Firstly, I want to emphasize that I have already filed an amendment to my previous 2024 Financial Affairs F1 report to accurately reflect the debt I had at that time. Additionally, I have included the necessary updates on my 2025 F1 report. This demonstrates my commitment to transparency and compliance with all regulations.

Regarding the specific debts mentioned by Mr. Kunzler, I would like to clarify the following points:

1. **\*\*Heather Ridge Apartments\*\***: The debt referenced by Mr. Kunzler has been paid off in full and is no longer outstanding. This can be verified through the appropriate documentation letter attached to this email below

2. **\*\*Credit Concepts\*\***: The debt associated with Credit Concepts, which Mr. Kunzler refers to, is currently in the process of being settled. I am actively working towards resolving this matter.

Furthermore, I would like to address the claims made by Mr. Kunzler about my residency. Attached to this correspondence below as well, you will find the decision made by Auditor Garth Fell following a public hearing that challenged my voter registration. The outcome of this hearing affirmed that I am a resident of Lynnwood, in line with the information I provided. It is also important to note that the individuals who initiated the recent failed recall attempt against me that Mr Kunzler brought up, Being Diodato Boucsiequez, who is the chair of the Snohomish County Young Republicans, have also been behind these allegations regarding my residency as in the documents attached. This appears to be another politically motivated MAGA attack against me.

In closing, I respectfully request that the Public Disclosure Commission consider the evidence I have provided, which reflects my compliance and dedication to maintaining transparency in my financial affairs and residency status. I believe that these allegations stem from a politically charged environment rather than factual discrepancies.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. I look forward to resolving these issues and continuing to serve the community of Lynnwood.

Re: **In Re the Voter Registration Challenge of Joshua Binda**

On February 10, 2025, at 12:05 p.m., pursuant to chapter 29A.08 RCW, Diodato Boucsiequez filed a Voter Registration Challenge with the Snohomish County Auditor. He alleges that Joshua Binda does not reside at the address listed in his voter registration record. The purpose of this proceeding is to determine whether Mr. Binda resides at the address listed on his voter registration record.

I. **Factual Background**

On October 25, 2018, Joshua Binda registered to vote with the Snohomish County Auditor's Office ("Auditor"). Exhibit A. At the time of the voter registration challenge Mr. Binda was a voter with an "inactive status"<sup>1</sup> registered at 17403 52<sup>nd</sup> Ave W, Lynnwood WA, 98037 ("17403 52<sup>nd</sup> Ave W"). On March 25, 2025, Mr. Binda updated the address on his voter registration record to 19888 40<sup>th</sup> Ave. W, Lynnwood WA, 98036 ("19888 40<sup>th</sup> Ave. W"). Accordingly, the Auditor's Office updated his registration to active voter status. RCW 29A.08.630(1)(a).

On February 10, 2025, pursuant to chapter 29A.08 RCW, Mr. Boucsiequez, filed a Voter Registration Challenge ("Challenge"). Exhibit B. The Challenge alleges that Binda "does not reside at the address listed on his voter registration" 17403 52<sup>nd</sup> Ave W, and that Binda's actual residential address is "9900 12<sup>th</sup> Ave W Apt. P207, Everett WA 98204". ("9900 12<sup>th</sup> Ave W"). Id.

The Auditor determined that the Challenge was in proper form and alleged a factual basis sufficient to meet legal grounds for a challenge. RCW 29A.08.840(2). Within 72 hours of receiving the Challenge, the Auditor's Office published the Challenge on its website. See RCW 29A.08.835. On February 12, 2025, the Auditor sent letters, via certified mail, to all known addresses, notifying Binda that a Challenge had been received. RCW 29A.08.840. Exhibit C. The letter included a copy of the Challenge and notified Mr. Binda that a hearing on the

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<sup>1</sup> On December 18, 2024, Mr. Binda updated his address in VoteWA, the statewide voter registration database. Updating the address triggered the Auditor's Office to mail an acknowledgment notice to the updated address. The acknowledgment notice was returned to the Auditor's Office based on the address being incomplete. RCW 29A.08.620. As a result, the Auditor's Office updated Mr. Binda's status to "inactive."



Challenge would be held on February 27, 2025, at 11:00am. Mr. Boucsiequez was also notified of the hearing time and date. Id.

Due to scheduling conflicts, the parties agreed to reschedule the hearing to March 25, 2025, at 4:30 pm.

On March 25, 2025, the Auditor heard testimony from the parties. Mr. Boucsiequez provided nine exhibits, including three not contained in the original challenge. Exhibit D. Mr. Binda provided two exhibits in response to the Challenge. Exhibit E.

The Auditor considered the written documents submitted by the parties as well as in-person testimony in rendering his decision.

## II. Standards for Voter Registration Challenge

To register to vote, a voter must provide, on the registration application, “the actual physical residence of the voter in Washington.” RCW 29A.08.010. Registration of a person as a voter is presumptive evidence of his or her right to vote. RCW 29A.08.810(1). Knowingly providing false information on a voter registration form is class C felony. RCW 29A.08.210.

A voter’s registration may be challenged by any registered voter or the county prosecuting attorney. RCW 29A.08.810(2). A challenge to a voter’s registration must be based on personal knowledge and one of the following grounds:

- The challenged voter has been convicted of a felony that includes serving a sentence of total confinement under jurisdiction of the department of corrections, or a felony conviction in another state’s court or federal court and the voter is serving that sentence of total confinement and the person’s voting rights have not been restored under RCW 29A.08.520;
- The challenged voter has been judicially declared ineligible to vote due to mental incompetency under RCW 29A.08.515;
- The challenged voter resides at a different address than the residential address provided and is not subject to RCW 29A.04.151 or 29A.08.112;
- The challenged voter will not be eighteen years of age by the next general election; or
- The challenged voter is not a citizen of the United States.

RCW 29A.08.810(1).

To commence a challenge, the challenger must “file a signed affidavit subject to the penalties of perjury swearing that, to his or her personal knowledge and belief, having exercised due diligence to personally verify the evidence presented, the challenged voter either is not qualified to vote or does not reside at the address given on his or her voter registration record” based on one of the grounds listed above. RCW 29A.08.810(3).

When a challenge is based on the allegation that the voter does not live at the residential address provided, the challenger is required to either provide the challenged voter’s actual

residence on the challenge form or submit alternative evidence to verify that the challenged voter does not reside at the listed address. RCW 29A.08.810(1)(c)(i), (ii). If the challenge is based on alternative evidence, the challenger must exercise due diligence to verify that the voter does not reside at the address listed. RCW 29A.08.810(1)(c)(ii). Evidence of due diligence requires that the challenger:

- (A) Sent a letter with return service requested to the challenged voter's residential address provided, and to the challenged voter's mailing address, if provided;
- (B) Searched local telephone directories, including online directories, to determine whether the voter maintains a telephone listing at any address in the county;
- (C) Searched county auditor property records to determine whether the challenged voter owns any property in the county;
- (D) Searched the statewide voter registration database to determine if the voter is registered at any other address in the state; and
- (E) Searched the voter registration database of another state to determine if the voter is registered to vote in any other state.

Id.

The challenger bears the burden of proving that the challenged voter's registration is improper by clear and convincing evidence. RCW 29A.08.840(4). Clear and convincing evidence is "evidence sufficient to convince the trier of fact, that the fact at issue is highly probable." Colonial Imports v. Carlton NW, 121 Wn.2d 726, 735 (1993).

A voter may defend the challenge by providing evidence sufficient to convince the trier of fact that he or she resides at the location described on the registration record, or that the use of the location as a residence is supported by RCW 29A.08.112 or 29A.04.151, or by Article VI, Section 4 of the state constitution. RCW 29A.08.840(4). A voter may also update the address on his or her voter registration record prior to the hearing. RCW 29A.08.140.

### III. Decision of the Auditor

On March 25, 2025, Mr. Binda updated his voter registration address to 19888 40<sup>th</sup> Ave. W., Lynnwood Washington 98036. At the hearing when asked under oath whether this is the address where he physically resides, Mr. Binda responded affirmatively. Testimony of Binda.

*Question:* The address that you provided in your new updated voter registration, is that where you physically reside?

*Response:* Yes

Mr. Boucsiequez bears the burden of demonstrating by clear, cogent and convincing evidence that Mr. Binda does not reside at the address where he is registered. While Mr. Boucsiequez made several arguments regarding Mr. Binda's residency at 19888 40<sup>th</sup> Ave. W, those arguments were not supported by sworn declarations or other evidence sufficient to overcome

the presumption the Mr. Binda physically resides at the address where he is registered.<sup>2</sup> Because the challenger has not met his burden, the voter registration challenge is dismissed.

The decision of the county auditor is final, subject to judicial review by the superior court under chapter 34.05 RCW. RCW 29A.08.840(6). Accordingly, any person with standing may file an appeal of this decision in Superior Court within 30 days from the date of the decision. RCW 34.05.542.

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<sup>2</sup> The bulk of Mr. Boucsiequez's arguments and evidence relate to Mr. Binda's status at 17403 52<sup>nd</sup> Ave W, Lynnwood, WA and 9900 12<sup>th</sup> Ave W Apt. P207, Everett WA.. Because Mr. Binda updated his voter registration address on March 25, 2025, the Auditor does not need to decide the status of those prior addresses to resolve this challenge.



## Background

Registered voter JOSHUA BINDA, DOB 18 November 1999, (the "VOTER") is registered with a residence address of 17403 52ND AVE W LYNNWOOD, WA 98037 and a status of Inactive. There is no separate mailing address on file for the VOTER in the Voter Registration Database ("VRDB").

## History

I canvassed this address on 29 January 2025. At the time, I learned from two residents that were home that they have never heard of a Joshua Binda residing there. I have returned several times between 29 January 2025 and 4 February 2025 to speak with other residents but no one was home at the other six units.

## Letter

On 29 January 2025, I mailed eight letters USPS Certified Mail to the eight units certified to the address on file in the VRDB, notifying the VOTER that the residence address listed in the VRDB.

## Envelope

On or about 30 January 2025, letters to the residence address in the VRDB started being returned to me marked "Return To Sender - Not Deliverable As Addressed - Unable to Forward". I am still awaiting a few of them back as the letters are being held by the Post Office for signature pickup. A notice was left at the door of each unit by the Post Office.

## Data Searches

### Source 1: Washington Secretary of State

As of 03 February 2025, the Washington Secretary of State website (containing voter registration data of Washington State registered voters) shows Joshua Binda with a birthyear of 1999 with a residence address of 17403 52<sup>nd</sup> Ave West, Lynnwood, WA 98037. The voter last voted in the 2024 General Election (11/5/2024) with a voter registration status of INACTIVE.

### Source 2: FEC Statement of Candidacy Form, FEC Form 2

When the voter filed to run for Congress in 2024, he had to complete FEC Form 2 Statement of Candidacy in which he certified to the federal government the address of 9900 12<sup>th</sup> Ave West Apt

P207, Everett, WA 98204, contrary to the residence address of 17403 52<sup>nd</sup> Ave West, Lynnwood, WA 98037 in the voter's registration.

### **Source 3: Protection Order** <https://lynnwoodtimes.com/2025/02/04/protection-order/>

In a protection order filed 28 January 2025 with the Snohomish County Superior Court by the voter against the Lynnwood Times, the voter used their evicted and trespassed address of 20409 68<sup>th</sup> Ave West, Unit H302, Lynnwood, WA 98036 as his address from which the voter sought protection. However, this is the address from which the voter is evicted and trespassed. Additionally, the voter stated 9900 12<sup>th</sup> Ave West Apt P207, Everett, WA 98204 as the voter's mailing address in the protection order.

### **Source 4: PDC F-1 Form** <https://apollo.pdc.wa.gov/public/financial-affairs/statement/122180>

In the voter's Financial Affair Disclosure, certified and filed by the voter on 29 July 2024, covering the period of 01 January 2023 – 31 December 2023, the voter listed his private speaking business' address as 9900 12<sup>th</sup> Ave W Apt P207, Everett, WA 98204.

### **Source 5: Cyber Background Checks**

Data obtained by Washington State Patrol's Washington Access to Criminal History (WATCH) tool shows no criminal record for Joshua Binda with a birthyear of 18 November 1999.

### **Source 6: Snohomish County Property Search**

A Snohomish County Property Search conducted on 29 January 2025 shows that there is no real property in Snohomish County owned in the name Joshua Binda. However, he does have a judgement against him owing over \$10,000 for an eviction at Heather Ridge Apartments in Lynnwood with address 20409 68<sup>th</sup> Ave West, Unit H302, Lynnwood, WA 98036 from which he was also trespassed. This was listed as his former voter registration address.

### **Source 7: Snohomish County Jail Roster**

As of 09 February 2025, the Snohomish County Jail Roster search shows no current inmates with the name of Joshua Binda.

## Source 8: Washington DOC Inmate Search

As of 09 February 2025, the Washington Department of Corrections search shows no current incarceration for anyone named Joshua Binda.

## Source 9: Federal Bureau of Prisons

Data obtained from this source on 29 January 2025 does not show any records for Joshua Binda residing or voting in any other state aside from the State of Washington.


## Conclusion

JOSHUA BINDA does not currently reside at 17403 52ND AVE W LYNNWOOD, WA 98037, the address listed in his voter registration. The data indicates that: the voter's registration is INACTIVE according to the Washington Secretary of State's Voter Registration Database, used the Everett address to file with the FEC when they filed to run for Congress, used the evicted and trespassed address in Lynnwood and the Everett address in the protection order against the Lynnwood Times, used the Everett address in their PDC Financial Affair Disclosure form, does not own property in Snohomish County, and has no landline phone number in Snohomish County. The multiple letters to the voter posted to the residence address was returned marked "Return To Sender - Not Deliverable As Addressed - Unable to Forward." All data points to the voter currently living at 9900 12<sup>th</sup> Ave W Apt P207, Everett, WA 98204, NOT at the address of 17403 52ND AVE W LYNNWOOD, WA, as the voter says in their voter registration.

This voter meets the requirements for a successful voter challenge under RCW 29A.08.810. It is therefore respectfully requested the voter be removed forthwith from the roll or the government show good cause in writing why the voter may not be so removed from the roll.

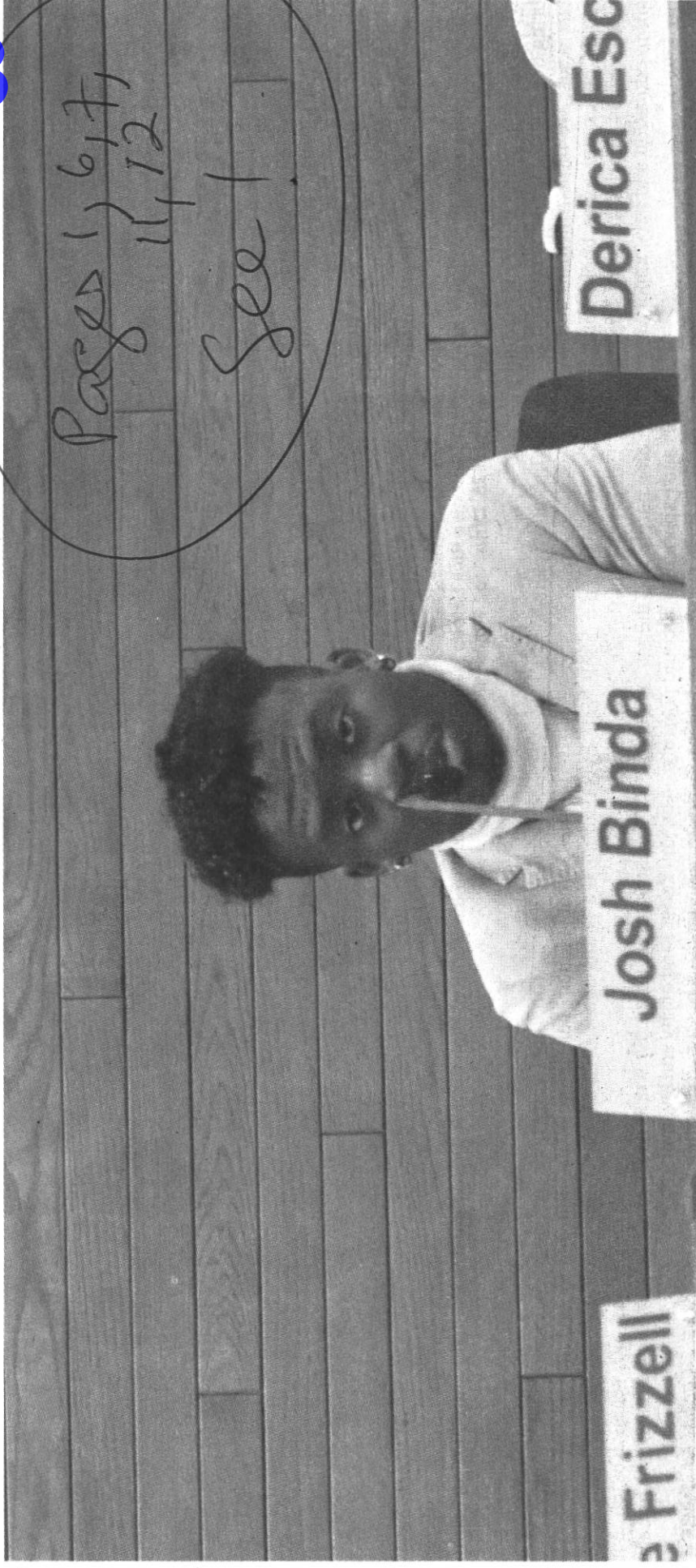

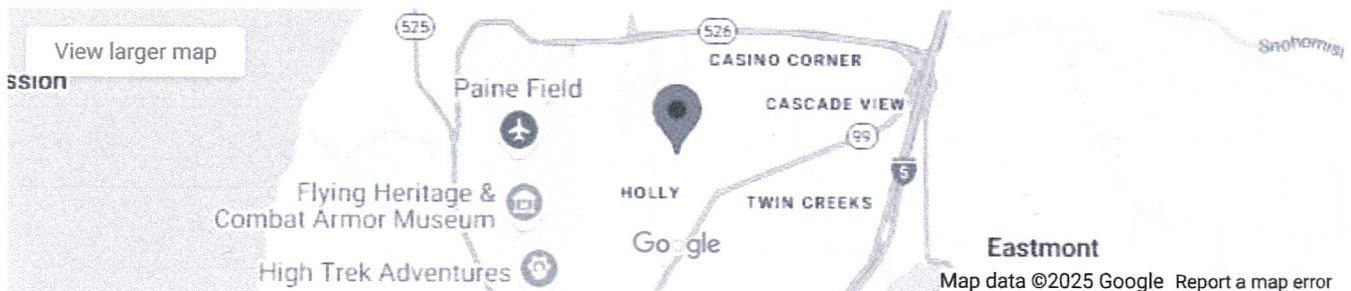

**Statement for Anthrassment Protection Order**

**To the Honorable Judge of Snohomish County Superior Court:**

**I am writing to formally request an anthrassment protection order against Mario**

Lohmore, the owner of The Lynnwood Times. The series of events that I have experienced as the youngest elected official in Lynnwood history, include stalking, harassment, invasion of privacy, and creating false identities in an attempt to trick me. These incidents have profoundly affected my and my family's emotional well-being, safety, and sense of security.

The most recent incident includes significant surveillance and monitoring of my movements by an investigator hired by Mr. Lohmore in order to create a false narrative for a story in The Lynnwood Times. According to the article in The Lynnwood Times, this investigator surveilled me on three separate occasions between December 2024 and January 2025. Reading the Times' own reports confirmed my fear that I was being followed and monitored without my consent.

From the article in The Lynnwood Times:

1. "Surveillance Incident 1": On December 9, 2024, after a city council meeting, I was observed leaving City Hall with Councilwoman Derica Escamilla. The investigator tracked our movements to her residence and then to a restaurant where we had dinner.

2. "Surveillance Incident 2": On January 13, 2025, the investigator again followed me and Councilwoman Escamilla, documenting our conversations and movements as we arrived at my dad's south Everett apartment, where I was house-sitting for him while he was out of the country.

3. "Surveillance Incident 3": On January 21, 2025, I was once again followed after a city council meeting. I was observed at the Lynnwood Library and later at Wendy's before boarding a bus to Everett. The investigator recorded my every move, including my pacing outside my apartment while discussing personal matters on the phone.

The most disturbing event occurred on January 23, 2025, when a fake delivery man (The Lynnwood Times described this person as "an undercover decoy" and admitted to working with this person) delivered a fake package to my father's apartment. I was completely unaware that the package was not legitimate when I signed for it, very early in the morning. The label on the package was not a real label. I do not know what kind of delivery form they had me sign so early in the morning. I had been expecting a package that very day, so I did not flag the incident as unusual when it first happened. When I opened the package, it included two cans of vegetables inside, that is it. That is when I realized that the label on the package wasn't real.

The emotional toll of these incidents has been significant. I feel incredibly violated and now feel like accepting and opening packages either within my own home or within the home of family members is no longer safe for me to do. The "undercover decoy" hired by The Lynnwood Times also used the delivery of the fake package to try to ask me questions, while I was half awake, related to the smear campaign story that they were working on.

This level of monitoring has created a pervasive sense of dread in my daily life for both myself and members of my family. My family and I now live in constant fear of being monitored or approached by Mr. Lohmore or his associates. My sense of safety has been

shattered. I have found myself feeling anxious and paranoid, unable to feel safe engaging in daily activities without the nagging worry that I am being monitored, stalked, or that delivermen for others in uniforms) are fake "decoys" pretending to do those jobs so that they can monitor my behavior on behalf of Mr. Lotmore.

While I have not yet reported these incidents to law enforcement, the pattern of behavior displayed by Mr. Lotmore constitutes harassment, stalking, and fraudulent activities. I am requesting this protection order to prevent any further harassment and fraud, to restore the sense of security in my life.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. I hope you will consider my request to help ensure my safety.

I would like to add further incidents of harassment and stalking by Mario Lotmore that have exacerbated my fear and anxiety regarding my safety.

In October 2021, Mario Lotmore stalked my former partner, Christy Koko, at her residence in Seattle. He attempted to question her about our relationship and even doxxed her address in his newspaper, leaving her feeling extremely uncomfortable and unsafe. It was only after my consultant, Rial Johnson, confronted him about his actions that he removed the offending content. This blatant disregard for privacy is deeply troubling and illustrates a pattern of harassment.

Additionally, in the same month, Mario showed up at my place of residence and interrogated my landlord, Justin Warlick, about my residency and rental situation. This invasion of my personal life by questioning my landlord created an atmosphere of unease and made me feel as though my home was no longer a safe space.

Furthermore, on April 27, 2023, Mario published false stories about my city ethics attorney, falsely claiming that I was guilty of using my office for monetary gain. This was not only defamatory but also misleading. An email from my city ethics attorney Noel Treat confirmed that he had not made any determination regarding my case and that he does not dictate the final outcome. This type of public character assassination has caused significant emotional distress and anxiety.

These incidents collectively paint a picture of persistent harassment and an invasion of my privacy that have profoundly affected my mental well-being. I respectfully urge the court to consider these additional factors in my request for an anti-harassment protection order against Mr. Lotmore.

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**Neighbors ID Binda** On January 22, 2025, several neighbors at the south Everett apartment positively identified Council Vice President Binda from his City Council headshot picture when it was presented to them. The neighbors said that to the best of their knowledge they thought the person in the picture lived at the residence as they see Council Vice President Binda entering and leaving the apartment almost daily or on the property frequently.

**Package Delivery:** At approximately 8 a.m. on January 23, 2025, an undercover courier delivered a package to the south Everett apartment for which Binda accepted and signed.

The Lynnwood Council Vice President answered the door shirtless and in his underwear. He then proceeded to tell the undercover courier that he was expecting his laptop to be delivered today. The courier asked Binda how long he lived at the south Everett apartment to which Binda answered, "technically this is my dad's place." The courier did not follow up with a question and left.

The Lynnwood Times was able to confirm that the south Everett apartment where Council Vice President Binda is allegedly living is leased to Binda's father.

- (c) Any intentional or knowing touching or fondling of the genitals, anus, or breasts, directly or indirectly, including through clothing, that the petitioner is forced to perform by another person or the respondent;

- (d) Any forced display of the petitioner's genitals, anus, or breasts for the purposes of arousal or sexual gratification of the respondent or others;
- (e) Any intentional or knowing touching of the clothed or und clothed body of a child under the age of 16, if done for the purposes of sexual gratification or arousal of the respondent or others; or any coerced or forced touching or fondling by a child under the age of 16, directly or indirectly, including through clothing, of the genitals, anus, or breasts of the respondent or others.

"Sexual penetration" means any contact, however slight, between the sex organ or anus of one person by an object, the sex organ, mouth, or anus of another person, or any intrusion, however slight, of any part of the body of one person or of any animal or object into the sex organ or anus of another person including, but not limited to, cunnilingus, fellatio, or anal penetration.

Evidence of emission of semen is not required to prove sexual penetration.

"Stalking" means any of the following:

- (a) Any act of stalking as defined under RCW 9A.46.110;
- (b) Any act of cyber harassment as defined under RCW 9A.90.120; or
- (c) Any course of conduct involving repeated or continuing contacts, attempts to contact, monitoring, tracking, surveillance, keeping under observation, disrupting activities in a harassing manner, or following of another person that:
  - (i) Would cause a reasonable person to feel intimidated, frightened, under duress, significantly disrupted, or threatened and that actually causes such a feeling;
  - (ii) Serves no lawful purpose; and
  - (iii) The respondent knows, or reasonably should know, threatens, frightens, or intimidates the person, even if the respondent did not intend to intimidate, frighten, or threaten the person.

"Unlawful harassment" means:

- (a) A knowing and willful course of conduct directed at a specific person that seriously alarms, annoys, harasses, or is detrimental to such person, and that serves no legitimate or lawful purpose. The course of conduct must be such as would cause a reasonable person to suffer substantial emotional distress, and must actually cause substantial emotional distress to the petitioner, or
- (b) A single act of violence or threat of violence directed at a specific person that seriously alarms, annoys, harasses, or is detrimental to such person, and that serves no legitimate or lawful purpose, which would cause a reasonable person to suffer substantial emotional distress, and must actually cause substantial emotional distress to the petitioner. A single threat of violence must include:
  - (i) A malicious and intentional threat as described in RCW 9A.36.080(1)(c); or
  - (ii) the presence of a firearm or other weapon.

For the one occasion which Binda was not witnessed to have concluded his travel to the south Everett apartment, the surveillance ended prematurely when the councilman was directly observed at a dinner with a fellow councilwoman at a Lynnwood restaurant late into the night after the city council meeting. The surveillance was called off and did not continue after Binda and the councilwoman left the restaurant together after dinner.

An undercover decoy posing as a courier was able to obtain a signature from Council Vice President Binda at the south Everett apartment on January 23, 2025.

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Below are the findings from the surveillance by the experienced investigator and an undercover decoy.

**Surveillance 1.** After the city council meeting on December 9, 2024, Councilman Binda was observed leaving with Councilwoman Derica Escamilla in her vehicle from City Hall – she was the driver.

The vehicle with both Binda and Escamilla drove to Escamilla's residence and parked outside of her residence – neither person ever left the vehicle.

After several minutes, the vehicle with both Binda and Escamilla then left her place where they went to Olive Garden on 196<sup>th</sup> Street in Lynnwood and were observed having dinner together. Because it was getting late, past 10:30 p.m., the experienced investigator called off the surveillance.



At approximately 8:30 p.m., the councilman left Wendy's to the Community Transit Blue Swift Line's 196th St SW NB Station located at 196<sup>th</sup> Street and HWY 99.

Binda was directly observed boarding the 9:09 p.m. Blue Swift Line BRT to Everett. The bus arrived at the 4<sup>th</sup> Ave W NB Station in south Everett at approximately 9:21 p.m. where Binda was observed leaving the bus.

At approximately 9:29 p.m. Binda arrived at the *south Everett apartment* where he paced back-and-forth on the sidewalk in front of the apartment building for approximately 2 minutes speaking on the phone with a female about how to "work Nick," addressing "naysayers" on council, and discussing a "youth council."

Still on the phone, Councilman Binda was directly (firsthand) observed proceeding to the door of the *south Everett apartment*, unlocked the door, then entered the unit at approximately 9:32 p.m.

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# Does the Lynnwood Council VP live in Lynnwood? It's hard to say.

Josh Binda's residency has been called into question following an eviction and FEC filings listing an Everett address. He insists he lives in Lynnwood.

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LYNNWOOD — Lynnwood City Council Vice President Josh Binda lives in Lynnwood, right?

It's not so clear.

Binda's residency has been called into question after a 2023 eviction and his voter registration status being listed as inactive. The 25-year-old also wrote an Everett apartment as his address on a number of public documents during his 2024 run for a seat on the U.S. House of Representatives.

His residency has been a topic of discussion for weeks between community members and fellow council members after an article published Jan. 27 by the Lynnwood Times alleged Binda may be living in Everett.

Binda vehemently denies the allegations and maintains that he is a Lynnwood resident. Some members of the body, like Council President Nick Coelho, have backed Binda in city council meetings. Others, like council members Patrick Decker and David Parshall, have sought additional proof of residency from Binda.

State law requires elected officials to be residents of the city for at least a year before they can run for office. If an elected official ceases to be a legally registered voter of the city they represent, their seat will be vacated.

Lynnwood's municipal code, however, doesn't specify any other residency requirements for its City Council members beyond state law.

On Monday, council member Decker suggested amending city code to require council members to provide proof of residency upon request, once every three months at the most. Proof of residency documents would be the same as those required by the Washington Department of Licensing to receive a Real ID.

Those documents could include a vehicle registration or title, a cell phone bill, a home utility bill, bank statements, voter cards and auto insurance policies, among others.

Decker asked Lynnwood's city attorney, Lisa Marshall, to bring back language to the council that the body could vote on at an upcoming meeting.

The City Council and the mayor don't have the power to remove Binda from his seat. A court must find that he is not a resident of the city. Previous cases have used utility bills, driver's licenses and voter registration as proof of residency.

"I take my responsibilities very seriously as a city council member," council member David Parshall said Monday. "Just because nothing has happened yet doesn't mean we are not taking things seriously."

Binda was evicted from a Lynnwood apartment in 2023 after he did not pay rent for more than six months, court records show. On Monday, he said in a City Council meeting it was due to him losing his job.

Current voter registration data shows Binda living at a different Lynnwood address than the apartment he was evicted from. But in April 2024, Binda filed with the Federal Election Commission to create a campaign committee, People For Josh Binda, as he sought a seat in the U.S. House. In that filing, Binda listed an Everett apartment — his father's home, he said Monday — as his address.

His listed contact address on the Secretary of State's website for that election, however, is the apartment in Lynnwood he was evicted from. Binda filed the document in May 2024, records show, months after he was evicted.

"His FEC filing, which he signed and swore was true and correct, under penalty of perjury, he wrote down his address being in Everett," Decker said Monday. "I don't know how you get clearer. Council member Binda has sworn in a statement — you can go look, go the FEC, look it up — he swore that he lived in Everett at the time he filed that."

Binda's motivational speaking company, Josh Binda Speaks, is also registered at the apartment he was evicted from in 2023, according to state corporation records. A financial affairs disclosure form he submitted to the state Public Disclosure Commission in July 2024, however, lists that company's address as an Everett apartment — the same one he listed on the Federal Election Commission filing.

Binda listed an Everett address in his Federal Election Commission filing because his family had concerns over his safety, he said in an interview Thursday, but was unsure why the Secretary of State's records showed his mailing address in Lynnwood when he was evicted from that property months later.

After he was evicted in 2023, Binda was "couch surfing," he said, between his family's homes in the area. He temporarily lived with his aunt in Lynnwood then house-sat for his father in Everett between December 2024 and January

2025 at the address listed in his Federal Election Commission document. He is now living with family in Lynnwood, he said, but did not provide documentation to The Daily Herald proving his residency.

Binda also said he was fearful of his family's safety when running for the federal seat because of scrutiny, harassment and hate mail he said he's received during his time as a council member.

"I don't want to do anything to jeopardize my family further than what my work on council has already put me through," Binda said Thursday. "I think the questions around this are just bizarre to me. I was caught at my father's home during the holidays, house sitting, and I thought that wouldn't be unusual for anyone, especially a young person."

Physically moving for a short period of time does not necessarily denote a change of permanent residence, according to the Municipal Research and Services center, a nonprofit which provides legal guidance to municipal governments. Generally, unless an individual shows an intent to abandon their old residence by establishing residency outside of their municipality, the person would still be eligible to hold office, wrote Flannary Collins, an attorney at the research center.

If a council member owns or rents more than one property, it then becomes a question of which one the official designates as their primary residence, an uncredited article for the research center reads, which can be established by direct or indirect evidence.

"In terms of direct evidence, it is simple enough to ask the official which location they consider to be their permanent residence," the article says. "For indirect evidence, look at the address the official uses on their voter registration, driver's license, tax records, children's school enrollment forms, memberships in public parks and recreation programs, utility bills, and similar documents."

Binda has been embroiled in controversy before for ethics and campaign finance violations. In 2022 and 2023, the Public Disclosure Commission fined him more than \$1,300 after an investigation found Binda spent campaign funds on personal items, including plane tickets and luxury clothing. He still owes more than \$1,300 in fines issued by the commission, records show.

Later that year, Binda admitted to violating city ethics rules because he used City Council property to advertise his motivational speaking tour, from which he earned at least \$14,500.

When filing to run for office, the Snohomish County Auditor's Office verifies addresses by comparing the address a candidate provides with their voter registration records. Registering to vote requires a person list their physical residential address, Snohomish County Auditor Garth Fell said in an interview Monday, but does not require additional documentation to prove that address person's residence.

"In terms of the voter registration process, it is really that validation from the individual that is signing that oath, saying 'This is where I reside,' and many times that will match a driver's license or bills they receive," Fell said.

It is a felony to put incorrect information on voter registration documents and declaration of candidacy forms, Fell said. The United States Post Office also informs the auditor's office if a person has potentially moved from their address.

If the post office makes that determination, the person's voting status is listed as inactive.

Binda most recently voted in the November 2024 election, records show. The Secretary of State's office listed his status as inactive near the beginning of 2025, Fell said.

Inactive voters are still able to participate in elections, but they must first confirm their address with the auditor's office before their status is reactivated. Binda is still a registered voter in Lynnwood and will be for at least four more years, even if his status remains inactive, according to state law.

The auditor's office does not have the authority or responsibility to monitor the ongoing residency of elected officials, Fell added. His office makes checks during the filing process, but it's up to local jurisdictions to validate the residency of their officials. That's one reason council member Decker is looking to define residency specifically in Lynnwood's law.

"What I am proposing is that we clean up the language in our code to remove that confusion, to create clarity and to regain trust and credibility in the community," Decker said. "We can't just leave it as it is and say it was good enough before, it's good enough now, because the community does not think it's good enough."

However, another council member, Derica Escamilla, said putting additional rules on top of existing state law would be redundant.

"I'm concerned that we've gone too far in breaking that public trust to just say 'Oh, we checked the voting records with the auditor,'" council member Parshall said. "... At this point, the only way to remove a council member is resignation, or if we get some clarity from the courts on this. I think that's an opportunity for council member Binda to completely clear himself."

Snohomish County Superior Court would be responsible for filing an action against a sitting council member over residency concerns. Asking the court to do that, however, would be difficult and expensive, Lynnwood City Attorney Lisa Marshall said. It would also not be 100% certain that the court would accept the case and provide an opinion.

"Every city I've ever been city attorney for has had this discussion. No city has resolved it," Marshall told the council Monday. "... I guess if I had something to say that might kind of get you off of this impasse you seem to be on, what will you do if you do create this ordinance and you do create this criteria and you're still frustrated, because there's still discussion of where people live? I'm only offering that because in my experience, it tends to be a never-ending inquiry. ... just leave it at that."

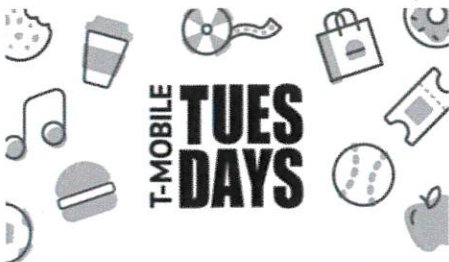
