


Public Disclosure Commission Statement of Understanding
Joshua Binda: PDC Case 166668

I, Joshua Binda (the Respondent), hereby acknowledge that, during calendar years 2022 and 2023, as an incumbent Lynnwood City Council Member, I violated RCW 42.17A.710 by failing to include debt of more than \$2,400 owed during the reporting period on Personal Financial Affairs Statements (F-1 reports) filed with the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) as required.

The Respondent would like to avoid the time and expense resulting from a Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (Brief Enforcement Hearing) before the Presiding Officer. Therefore, in lieu of a hearing, the Respondent acknowledges that he violated RCW 42.17A.710 and agrees to enter into this *Statement of Understanding* to resolve this matter with the Public Disclosure Commission.

The Respondent understands that by signing this SOU, they acknowledge the violations of RCW 42.17A and Title 390 WAC set forth above and waive their right to a hearing in this matter. The Respondent further understands that signing this SOU and returning it to the PDC will resolve the issue of the inaccurate F-1 reports.
