Subject: PDC Case 167743 regarding The Pend Oreille County Democrats

The Pend Oreille County Democrats:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) completed its review of the complaint filed by Conner Edwards on December 21, 2024. The complaint alleged violations of RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 for failure to timely and accurately report contributions and expenditures.

Applicable Laws and Rules

- [RCW 42.17A.235](#) describes the required filing deadlines for disclosure of campaign finance activities including monetary contributions.
- [RCW 42.17A.240](#) requires committees to file accurate campaign finance reports with the Public Disclosure Commission.

Background and Findings

- The Pend Oreille County Democrats was a Bonafide County Non-Exempt committee that was registered under full reporting during calendar year 2024.
- The Respondent filed their C-4 covering February 6, 2024, through February 28, 2024, on December 19, 2024, disclosing \$244.69 in expenditures. This report was 283 days late, having been due March 11, 2024.
- The Respondent filed their C-3 report disclosing \$240 in contributions on November 11, 2024. This report was 153 days late, having been due June 10, 2024.
- Additionally, the Respondent failed to provide complete expenditure details on C-4 reports.

Summary and Resolution

Having reviewed the complaint and the supporting evidence, PDC staff has determined that there is evidence of a violation of RCW 42.17A. Based on the guidance provided to PDC staff by the Commission at the January 23, 2025, Commission meeting, this matter is being dismissed in accordance

with [RCW 42.17A.755\(1\)](#). While PDC staff is not requiring that you address the allegations at this time, you are encouraged to bring your reporting into full compliance, particularly for political advertising for which reporting should include information about the quantities, run dates and which campaigns were supported or opposed.

Any allegations regarding reporting by you for calendar year 2024 that are not otherwise addressed are hereby dismissed. You are required to comply with all PDC requirements in the future, and failure to do so could lead to enforcement action.
