Complaint Description
<p>Maxwell Villella reported via the portal (Sun, 23 Mar 2025 at 7:21 PM)</p> <p>1) RCW 42.17A.205 states that "(1) Every political committee shall file a statement of organization with the commission. The statement must be filed within two weeks after organization or within two weeks after the date the committee first has the expectation of receiving contributions or making expenditures in any election campaign, whichever is earlier."</p> <p>According to Erika Evans's campaign website domain registration records (attached), the domain was registered/purchased on 2/4/25 yet her campaign did not officially file with the PDC until 3/3/25 (attached), 27 days later. Her campaign should have registered with the PDC on 2/18/25 at the absolute latest, so this is clearly outside the two week period and in direct violation of RCW 42.17A.205.</p> <p>2) According to RCW 42.17A.700, "Within two weeks of becoming a candidate, every candidate shall file with the commission a statement of financial affairs for the preceding twelve months." The PDC also states that "According to the disclosure law, you become a candidate when you do one of these things: accept a contribution or spend money for your campaign; reserve space or purchase advertising to promote your candidacy; authorize someone else to do any of these activities for you; state publicly that you are seeking office; or file a declaration of candidacy."</p> <p>https://www.pdc.wa.gov/registration-reporting/candidates-committees/candidate-faq</p> <p>Since Erika Evans legally became a candidate by purchasing her campaign website domain on 2/4/25, she should have filed her F1 report on 2/18/25 at the latest, yet her F1 was filed on 3/17/25 (image attached).</p> <p>3) RCW 42.17A.235 states that "(3)(a) Each treasurer of a candidate or political committee shall file with the commission a report on the tenth day of each month during which the candidate or political committee is not participating in an election campaign, only if the committee has received a contribution or made an expenditure in the preceding calendar month and either the total contributions received or total expenditures made since the last such report exceed two hundred dollars."</p> <p>While purchasing a website domain would not cross the \$200 in expenditures, the campaign would need to also purchase a website platform. Looking at her website's source code (image attached), she is using the wordpress platform. Additionally, it is clear from looking at her website that she has had professional photography taken (attached), which also most likely cost over \$200 alone. And since her campaign filed on 3/3/25, it is extremely likely the photography took place in February and should have been reported on 3/10/25. As of the time of this complaint however (3/23/25) there has not been a single C4 report filed by the campaign.</p>
What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?
Prevents the public from knowing how much money Evans has actually raised as well as who she has received money from in addition to how her campaign is spending their money.

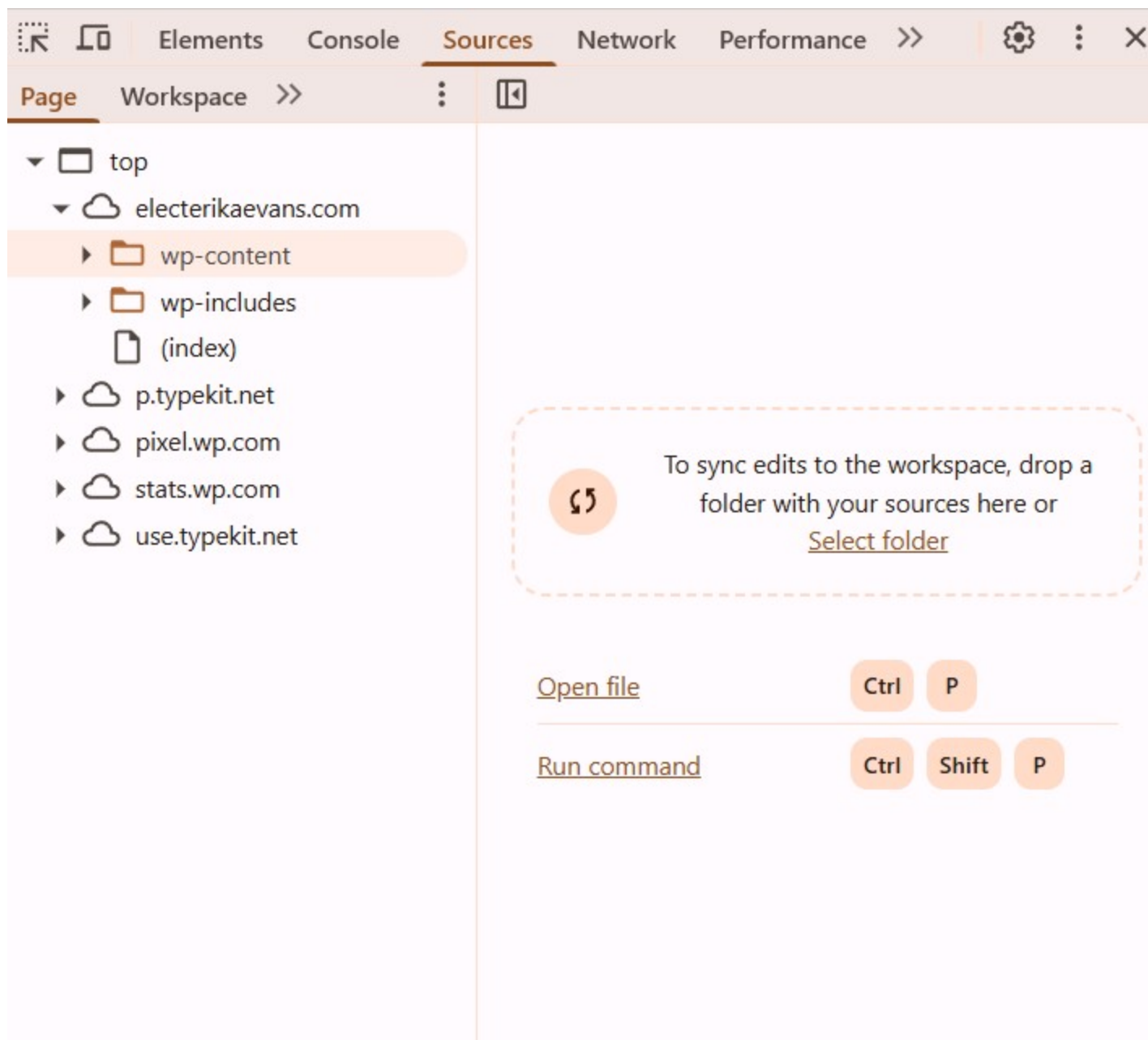
