As our original response explained, Erika Evans had not yet made a final decision to run for City Attorney as of February 4, 2025, when the domain name was purchased by the strategist. While she was seriously considering it, she was also weighing a number of other personal and professional options at the time—including not running at all.

The article cited by the complainant is, at best, a stylized, retrospective account by the reporter that does not capture the full nuance of Ms. Evans's deliberative process. The quote referencing a "final straw" reflects a turning point in her thinking, not a finalized decision or campaign action. The decision to run was not made until February 26, 2025, when she signed a strategist contract and formally moved forward with filing the C1 five days later.

The complainant conflates emotional conviction with legal candidacy. For the reasons set forth above, and in our prior response, this Complaint should be dismissed as being based on conduct that was not a willful violation, and any technical error on Ms. Evans' part had minimal impact on public transparency.
