Hello,

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to this complaint. Some of the allegations in the complaint are false, including information regarding the starting balance of the campaign and appear to mix years. In this response, I am limiting the comments to items 1 and 2 below only.

1. Failing to disclose vendor name and address for in-kind goods/services. For more guidance, please see: <https://pdc.wa.gov/registration-reporting/candidates-committees/contributions/kind-contributions>

The data entry for the PDC website unfortunately does not allow input of vendor name or address for in-kind contributions similar to the input for campaign expenses with campaign funds. This allegation appears to be specific to this bulleted item near the bottom of the provided link *"if the in-kind contribution is a good or service purchased from a vendor, include the name and the address of the vendor."*

To investigate this allegation, I reviewed all in-kind contributions reported for the 2025 City Council campaign (10) and the referenced 2024 Public Lands Commissioner campaign (19). Upon review of the campaign in-kind contributions, I found that it appears that the option available to address this complaint is to amend the entries to add the name and address of the vendor in the memo section of the data entry for in-kind contributions.

I amended the entries to include the name and address of the service providers. The ORCA tool automatically displays the new amended input and prints the record. It does not appear that a new submission is required for filing. I will note that the C4 reports themselves do not display information from the amended memo details to each entry.

2. Failure to identify contributors that approved contribution transfers from the 2024 campaign for Commissioner of Public Lands to the 2025 campaign. The 2024 Campaign for the Commissioner of Public Lands was self-funded. The approver for transfer of funds was me.

To address this complaint I added comments to the memo to be more specific. Similar to Item #1, the amendment does not change the information on the C3/C4 reports.
