<b>Complaint Description</b>
<p><u><a href="#">Jeff Lyon</a></u>  reported via the portal  (Wed, 21 May 2025 at 1:34 PM)</p> <p>This complaint supplements my earlier filing on March 28, 2025, regarding Troy Anderson's delayed submission of required financial disclosures.</p> <p>As of May 13, 2025, Mr. Anderson has filed three C-4 Summary Reports disclosing a total of \$2,128 in campaign expenditures. However, he has still not filed any C-3 reports disclosing contributions, nor has he reported any vendor debt on Schedule B. This combination is implausible and indicates that Mr. Anderson's campaign filings are materially incomplete.</p> <p>Under RCW 42.17A.235 and related WAC provisions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• C-3 reports are required for the disclosure of monetary and in-kind contributions, including any personal funds contributed to the campaign.</li> <li>• If a campaign incurs expenses without immediate payment, those obligations must be disclosed as vendor debt on Schedule B of the C-4.</li> </ul> <p>The absence of both contributions and vendor debt, despite documented spending of over \$2,000, means one or more of the following violations has occurred:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The campaign received contributions but failed to report them via C-3s;</li> <li>2. The candidate spent personal funds and failed to disclose them as candidate contributions or loans;</li> <li>3. The campaign incurred debt but failed to report it on Schedule B;</li> <li>4. The C-4s are otherwise inaccurate or misleading in their reporting of expenses.</li> </ol> <p>Accurate and timely reporting of all contributions, expenditures, and obligations is essential for public trust in the electoral process. Mr. Anderson's filings do not currently meet that standard.</p>
<b>What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?</b>
<p>This lack of financial disclosure obscures the sources of support and spending for Mr. Anderson's campaign. Voters are unable to assess whether campaign activities are being funded by special interests, personal wealth, or unpaid vendors. The public deserves clarity, and this campaign's filings do not provide it.</p>
