What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?
<p>Lack of fairness, transparency, and the integrity of the electoral process.</p> <p>Requiring disclosure of who is paying for political advertising, like disclaimers that identify the sponsoring individual or organization, helps voters understand who is trying to influence their vote and holds advertisers accountable. This promotes public confidence in the fairness of elections and governmental processes. By not following regulations other candidates are being placed at a disadvantage by facing unfairly high advertising costs or rates that differ from their opponents.</p>
