Re: Response to Complaint by Connor Edwards Against 32nd District Democrats

Dear Compliance Officers,

We are writing in response to the complaint filed by Mr. Connor Edwards against 32nd District Democrats, as reported on May 19, 2025. I appreciate the opportunity to address the allegations made in the complaint and provide our perspective on the matter.

First and foremost, we take campaign finance laws seriously and are committed to full compliance with Washington State's campaign finance regulations (RCW 42.17A). We understand the importance of transparency in political activities and the need to maintain public trust.

Late Reporting Allegations:

The complaint primarily focuses on the allegation that 32nd District Democrats have consistently filed late reports. This, of course, is true. We acknowledge that there have been instances of late reporting in the past, as mentioned in Mr. Edwards's complaint. We understand that these late reports can create skepticism and erode public confidence. The complaint further asserts that doing so represents a deliberate attempt to conceal political activity from the public. This couldn't be further from the truth. In fact, none of our reporting failures represent what the law refers to as "major violations, intentional violations, and [or] violations that could change the outcome of an election or materially affect the public interest." Notably, the complaint makes no effort whatsoever to even contemplate which, if any, elections could have been affected in any way by late reporting of such meager contributions and expenditures.

This committee is entirely volunteer run with routine officer turnover and no budget for hiring external compliance professionals.

We would like to emphasize that while we have faced challenges in the past, we have taken significant steps to improve our reporting practices. We have implemented stricter internal deadlines, increased oversight, and improved communication to ensure timely and accurate reporting in the future. We take this matter seriously and are committed to rectifying any past discrepancies.

Failure to List Vendor Information for In-Kind Contributions:

The complaint also alleges that we have failed to list vendor information for a certain in-kind contribution.

Note that in ORCA, while Monetary Expenditures include the option to indicate when an expenditure includes a reimbursement or payment to a sub-vendor with a checkbox and a field to include the Providing vendor; In-Kind Expenditures do not have such a checkbox or additional field. If it is desirable for the PDC to have this information included in reporting, that feature should be included in the software.

To address this issue, we have re-filed the referenced C-4 with the name of the vendor in the description field. Additionally, we will ensure that our team is properly trained to avoid such omissions in the future.

Impact on the Public:

We understand the importance of maintaining public trust, especially in the realm of campaign finance. Political committees, including very small ones like ours should set an example for adherence to the law, and we are committed to doing just that. Our goal is to provide the public with accurate and timely information regarding our activities, as they have a right to know.

In conclusion, we take Mr. Edwards's complaint seriously and are committed to addressing the concerns raised therein. We believe in transparency and accountability and are taking proactive steps to ensure compliance with campaign finance laws. We appreciate the opportunity to rectify any past shortcomings and reaffirm our commitment to the highest standards of legal and ethical conduct.
