Subject: Response to Complaint Regarding Campaign Yard Signs Case Number 174506

Dear Public Disclosure Commission,

Pam Orebaugh and her campaign take all matters of compliance very seriously and remain committed to full adherence with the guidance set forth by the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC). We appreciate the opportunity to respond to the recent complaint regarding campaign yard signs lacking sponsor identification.

Upon receipt of the notice from the PDC, we immediately re-reviewed the current regulations and confirm that all yard signs in question were purchased, printed, and reported as part of Pam Orebaugh's previous campaign for Central Valley School District Board Position 5 in 2021. These signs are now being re-used for her current campaign for the same position and are therefore exempt from the updated sponsor ID requirements that went into effect on June 6, 2024.

Prior to the campaign placing signs we reviewed and followed both of the PDC's relevant compliance resources, which we are including below for reference:

As stated in these guidelines, signs printed prior to June 6, 2024, and used again for the same office, are exempt from the updated sponsor ID requirements. The campaign has duly noted this re-use as per the PDC's recommendation, and the original purchase of the signs was fully reported as part of her previous campaign's financial disclosures.

We further note that an email regarding this matter was sent to the campaign on June 12, 2025; however, due to it being filtered into a spam folder, it was not discovered until the PDC's notice was received.

We appreciate Bryan's attention to detail and concern for transparency and accountability. Pam Orebaugh and her campaign will continue to ensure full compliance with all PDC rules and reporting standards.
