Subject: Request for Guidance Regarding Anonymous Contribution Allegation

Dear PDC Enforcement Officer,

I'm writing in response to a complaint submitted on July 10 regarding a \$500 cash contribution allegedly accepted by my campaign. I am committed to full compliance with all PDC rules and RCW 42.17A.

I would appreciate clarification on the following points to ensure the issue is resolved correctly:

1. The cash envelope was handed to me by an unidentified individual at a public event, with no name or contact information provided. Does this qualify as an anonymous contribution, and if so, what is the process for remitting the funds to the State Treasurer as required by RCW 42.17A.220(4)?
2. If the contribution was deposited before I recognized the issue, may I now refund or remit the appropriate amount? If the individual cannot be identified or located, how should the funds be handled?
3. Is there a required format or deadline for submitting a formal written response to the complaint and any amended reporting forms?

Thank you for your guidance and support in helping candidates meet transparency and ethical standards.
