Thank you for your message. I'm writing to formally respond to the complaint submitted to the PDC on July 7, 2025, regarding three alleged campaign finance violations.

1. Website Disclosure Statement:

I take full responsibility for the absence of the "Paid for by" disclosure on my campaign website.

This was an unintentional oversight, which I will have corrected tonight to comply with RCW 42.17A.320. I've ensured all future web and previously printed materials continue to include the required language.

2. Late Filing of C3 Report:

The C3 report was filed late due to a misunderstanding about report scheduling. I believed the donation needed to be filed with the associated C4 report due on the 10th of the month. As a first-time candidate managing my own compliance and accounting, I recognize this was an error and have taken steps to prevent future issues.

3. Anonymous Donation:

The \$500 in cash was received without identifying information and reported as an anonymous donation under RCW 42.17A.240(6). No attempt was made to circumvent the law, and all other contributions to my campaign are properly identified and disclosed.

I appreciate the opportunity to clarify these matters and remain committed to transparent, ethical campaigning in accordance with state law.
