Honorable Members and Staff of the Public Disclosure Commission,

Thank you for reaching out regarding PDC Case Number 175486. As requested, I have focused only on the two allegations you specified. If there is a need for additional information, please let me know.

Allegation One: Both OneWoodinville.org and OneWoodinville.vote are not "political committees" or a PAC as defined in the Washington State campaign finance, reporting, and disclosure provisions found in RCW 42.17A and in Title 390 WAC. This is further confirmed by application of the "primary purpose" test as described on the PDC webpage (<https://www.pdc.wa.gov/rules-enforcement/guidelines-restrictions/definition-political-committee>). Neither OneWoodinville.vote nor OneWoodinville.org have endorsed or opposed any candidate or ballot initiative in the 2025 election.

Allegation Two: No contributions have been received by OneWoodinville.org or OneWoodinville.vote and all funding is from my personal funds. No expenditures by OneWoodinville.org or OneWoodinville.vote have supported or opposed any candidate or issue in 2025. There has been no Electioneering as defined in RCW 42.17A.005(21)(a) nor any Independent Expenditure as defined in 42.17A.005(30)(a).


The complainant failed to provide the full contents of the OneWoodinville.vote Facebook ad, which I have provided below. Please note the ad text identifies no candidate and states none are supported by this project. Further, all screenshots submitted by the complainant of the local news blog OneWoodinville.org are of content posted prior to January 1, 2025, before any candidate filed for office.
