Phil,

I have resolved all of the issues identified in the complaint. I am self-funding my campaign and amended my C-4 to reflect this. I also amended my candidate registration to be mini-reporting. Please see specific comments below for each item and let me know if there are any further items to address.

- That the \$500 deposit of candidate's personal funds does not appear on Line 2 of the C-4 as a contribution received or at the top of Page 2 of the C-4 as a deposit. Please note, you need to amend your C-4 and change the campaign start date to May 1, 2025 rather than May 14, 2025. By making this change, Line 1 of your amended C-4 will be zero, Line 2 will show your \$500 contribution, and the \$500 deposit will appear at the top of Page 2. Contribution has been deleted. All expenses have been entered as in-kind donations as reflected in my amended C-4.
- That the Schedule A entry for the purchase of yard signs does not list the quantity of yard signs purchased. The quantity purchased needs to be added to the amended C-4 report. Contribution was removed and replaced with in-kind donation. QTY of signs was included in the description.
- That the purchase of yard signs has been miscategorized as digital advertising. The amended C-4 needs to include a selection of the yard signs category. Contribution was removed and replaced with in-kind contribution. QTY of signs was included in the description.
- That your campaign website fails to include the required "Sponsor Identification" as required by [RCW 42.17A.320](#) and [WAC 390-18-010](#). Be sure to include the words "Paid for by" with the sponsor's name and mailing address. See the linked rule for assistance. I don't think this is needed now that my C-4 properly documents that this was an in-kind contribution from myself. However, I have added the requested information for the purpose of closing this item. Please let me know if it can now be deleted.
- That you have not reported an expenditure or receipt of an in-kind contribution for the cost of your campaign post office box. If you personally paid for the post office box, you should report the cost as an in-kind contribution from you. An in-kind contribution for this cost has been added.
- That you have not reported an expenditure or receipt of an in-kind contribution for your candidate website or filing fee. There is no filing fee for position you are seeking, which you can address in your written response to the complaint. There is no filing fee for the position I am seeking.
