<p><a href="#">Patriciamullettwa</a> reported via the portal (Tue, 29 Jul 2025 at 8:11 PM)</p> <p>I am filing this complaint to report a potential violation of Washington State’s political advertising laws by Misty Flowers, a candidate for Whatcom County Council. Based on a photograph I possess of the candidate’s campaign yard sign, it appears to lack the required sponsor identification, as mandated by <b>RCW 42.17A.320</b> and <b>WAC 390-18-030</b>.</p> <p>The sign in question is located at the intersection of I-5 and Guide Meridian, just north of the Bellingham Country Club. I have attached a photograph of the sign for your reference.</p> <p><b>Relevant Statutes and Rules:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>RCW 42.17A.320:</b> Requires all political advertising, including yard signs, to include the sponsor’s name and address.</li> <li>• <b>WAC 390-18-030:</b> Specifies that sponsor identification on political advertising must be displayed in at least 10-point type or 10% of the largest font size used, whichever is greater, and must be set apart from any other printed matter.</li> </ul>
