AMENDED STATEMENT

I am unable to attend the hearing but would like to furnish an amended written statement based on correspondence I received in the mail from the PDC today:

Dear PDC Members:

I did not provide Public Disclosure Statements for almost 4 years as a result of severe medical issues resulting in numerous emergency hospital visits and approximately fifty 911 medical related visits to my home in Bremerton. I have attached the 911 log of visits (from 2009 to 2015) to my former home as proof. The majority of the medical emergency visits occurred in 2013 through 2015. These medical problems significantly contributed to my lack of understanding and ability to submit the required forms.

Eventually in 2016 I resigned from my Commission Duties and moved out of my house to be on full time assisted living due to my medical issues. My home was subsequently sold in 2017. In a conversation with Fox Blackhorn I was told I received notice on Oct 2018 by email and to my Bremerton address about the 250 dollar penalty. Unfortunately I no longer owned my Bremerton home and have been unable to access the yahoo email address for several years as my account was hacked. I had no awareness of the penalty or any PDC requests to submit forms. Until I received notice from a collection Agency to my Auburn address just a few months back did I realize what happened and my son took action on my behalf to help me.

With the assistance of my son I submitted all my public disclosures recently. Being a retired federal worker who is currently 88 years old and on a limited income with significant medical expenses, I respectfully and humbly request a waiver to the fines as a result of the problems I have described above.
