In keeping track of both the Wales and Backus campaigns, I realized that Dr.Wales has not accounted for several things in her expenditures beyond what was listed in the original complaint. There is, of course, a chance these items are listed under another item or categorized under the less than \$50 line item:

Her campaign website: <http://www.electlargo.com> is not listed.

Campaign T-shirts (see attached photo) are not accounted for.

Dr.Wales informed me personally on 8/24/17 that she worked with a company in Bellevue to teach her how to build and maintain her campaign website.

Dr.Wales told me personally on 8/24/17 that she hired/had 4 social media people to manage her Facebook presence. The first was the daughter of a ranking member of the Auburn Chamber of Commerce, I can not recall the second, the third was her daughter (assumed unpaid), and currently it is a guy from her husband's job.

Unless it was less than \$50, the Wales campaign has not listed the cost of their booth at the Auburn 4th of July festival.

Beyond these missed expenses, you will see in the attached photo (captured from Largo Wales' Facebook page) that at the City of Auburn's April Clean Sweep event Largo had those on her clean sweep team wear Elect Largo Wales shirts (as did she) and called them her 'Elect Largo Work Crew.' This was a city sponsored event, therefore to my knowledge breaching RCW 42.52.180.
